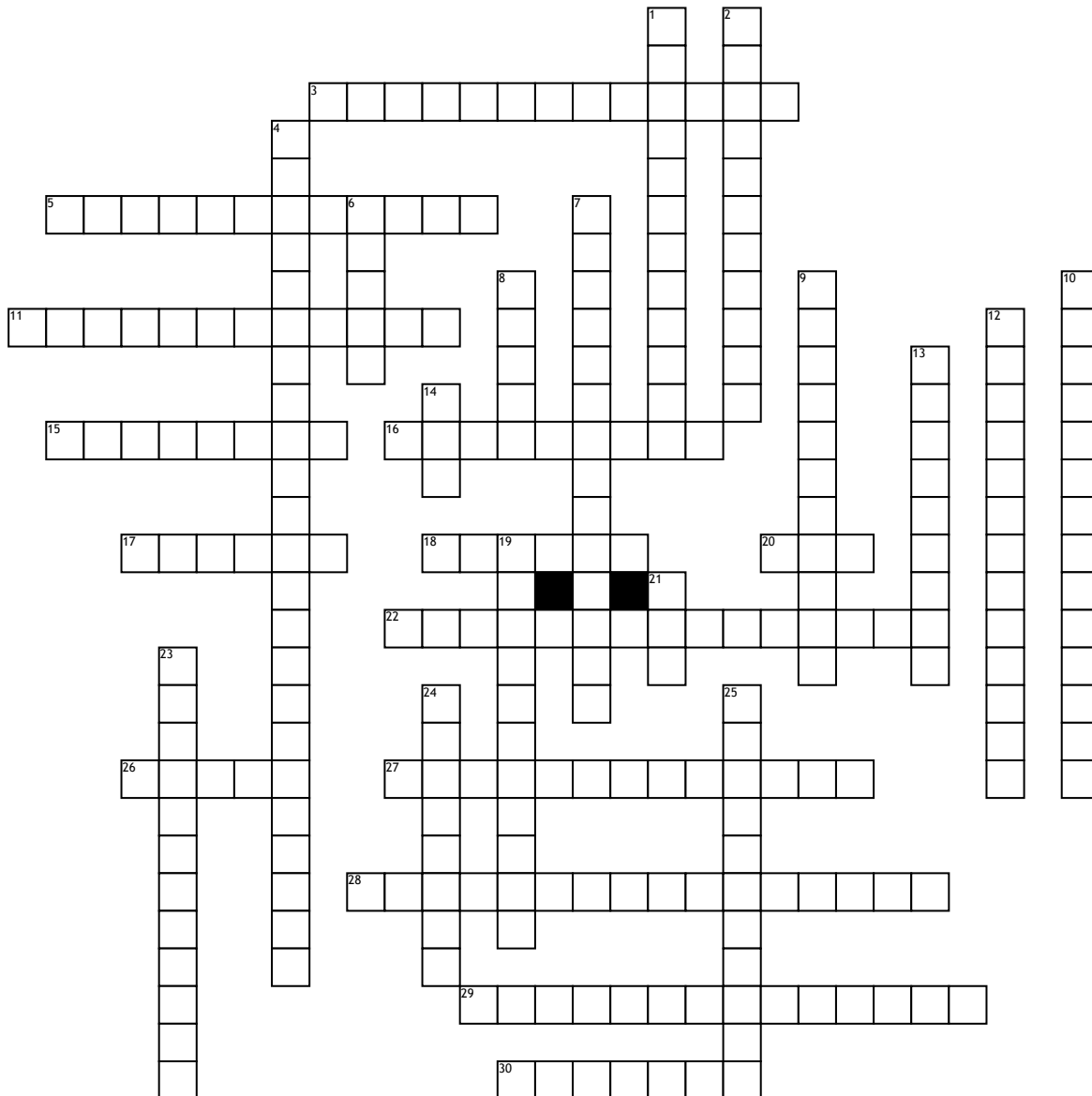


The Vietnam War
