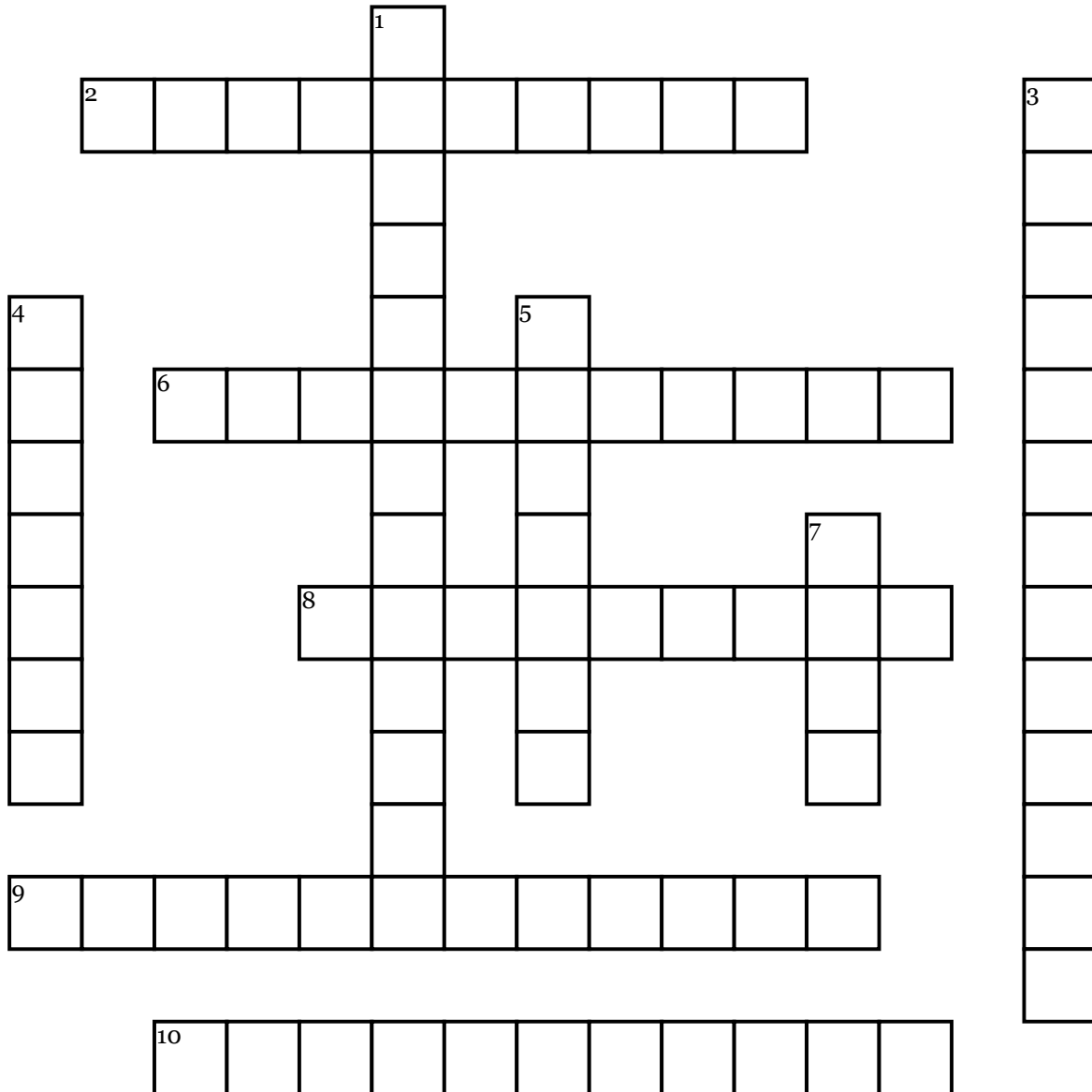


The Water Cycle
