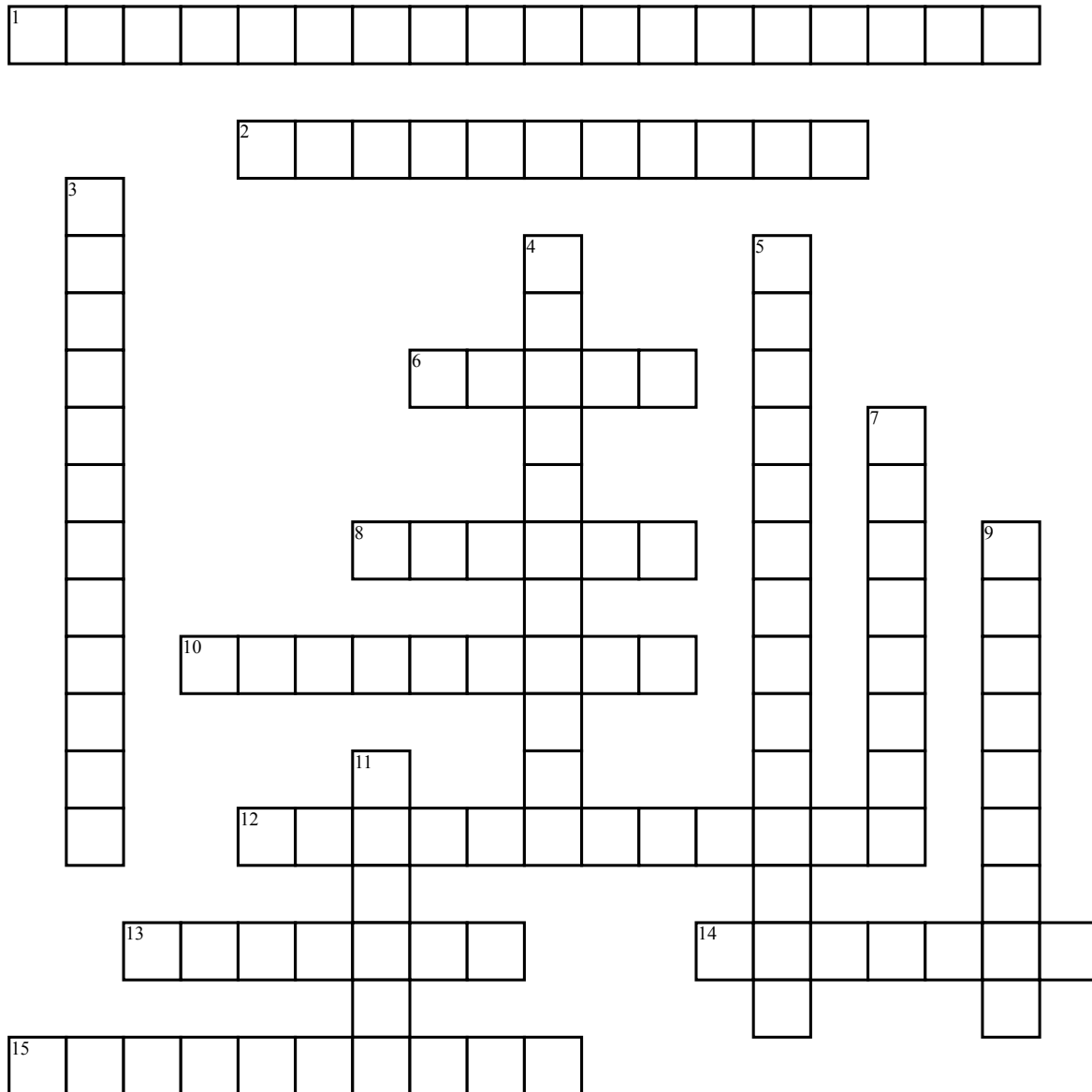


# The Watson's Crossword
