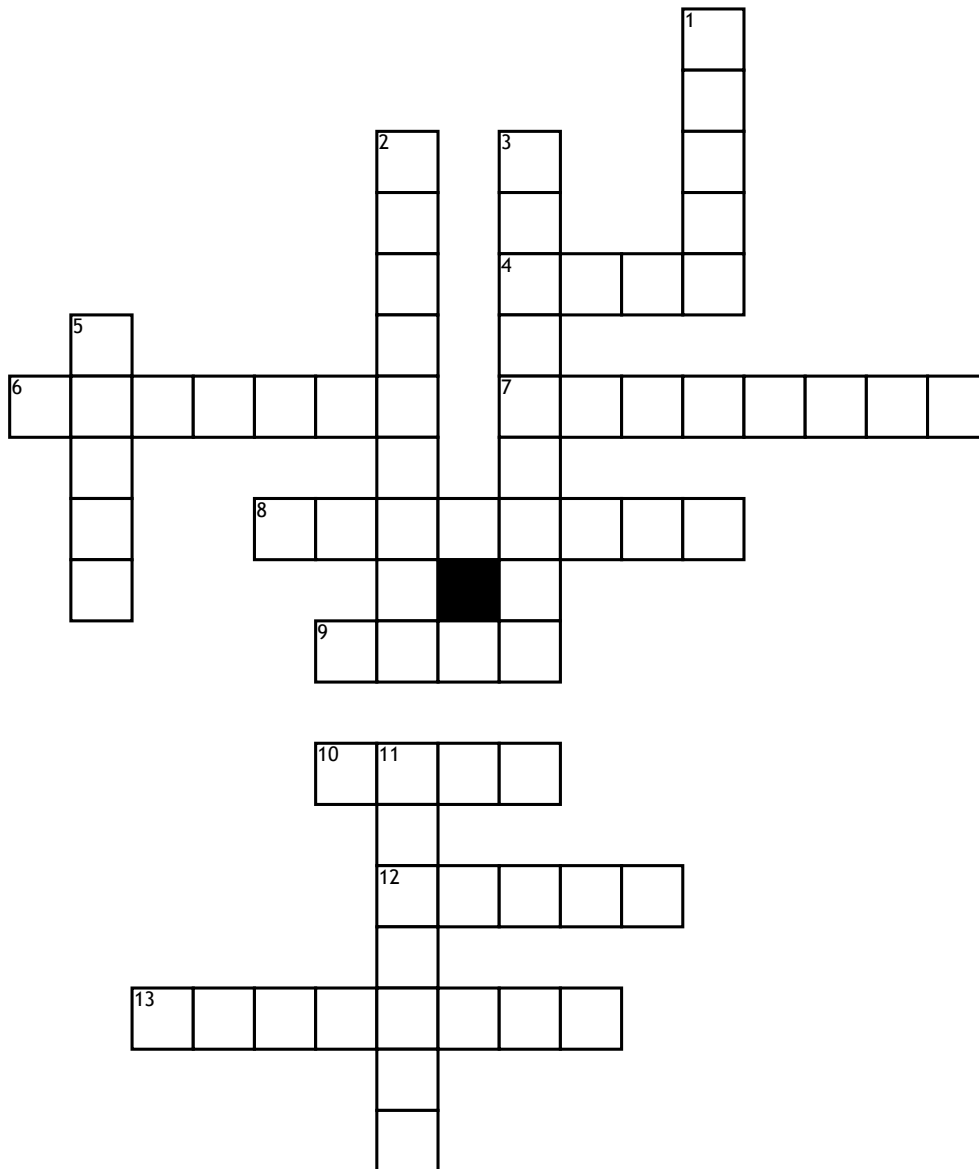


The Y Rule Crossword
