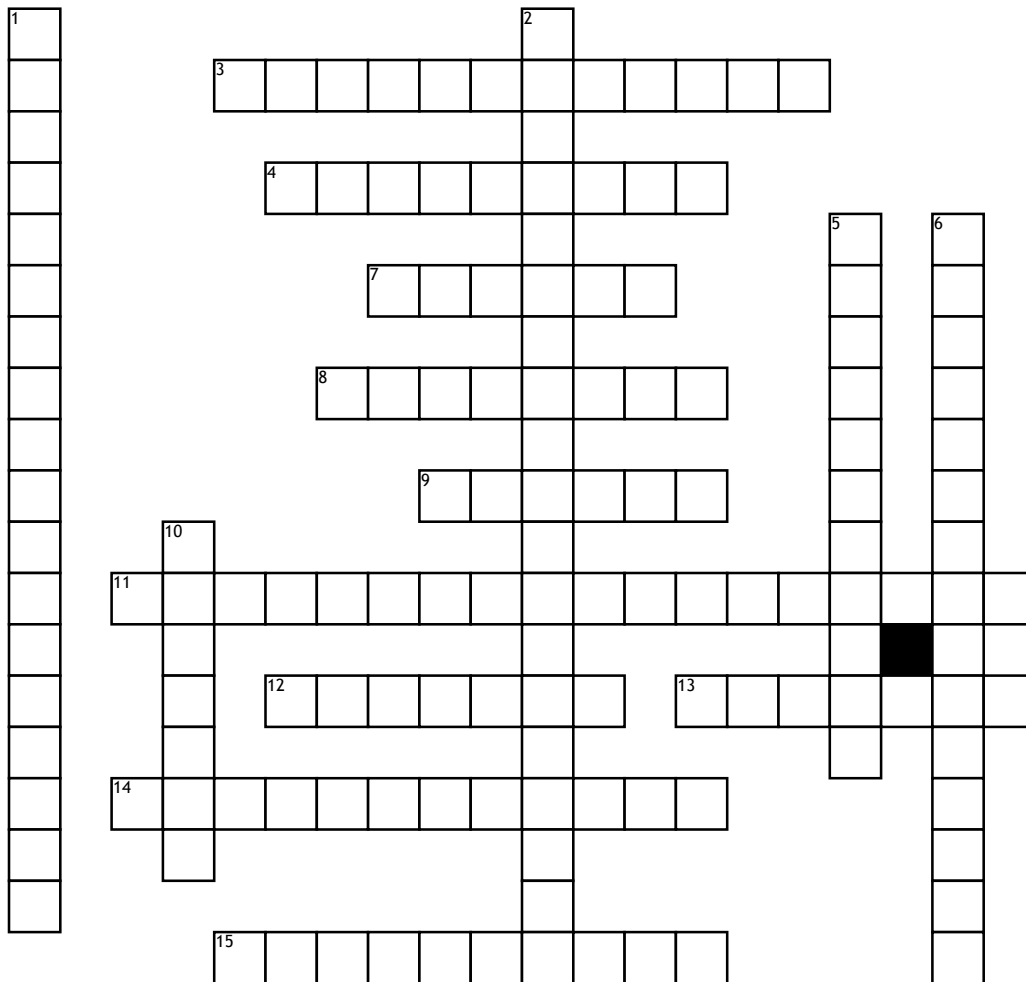


The cognitive system concept
