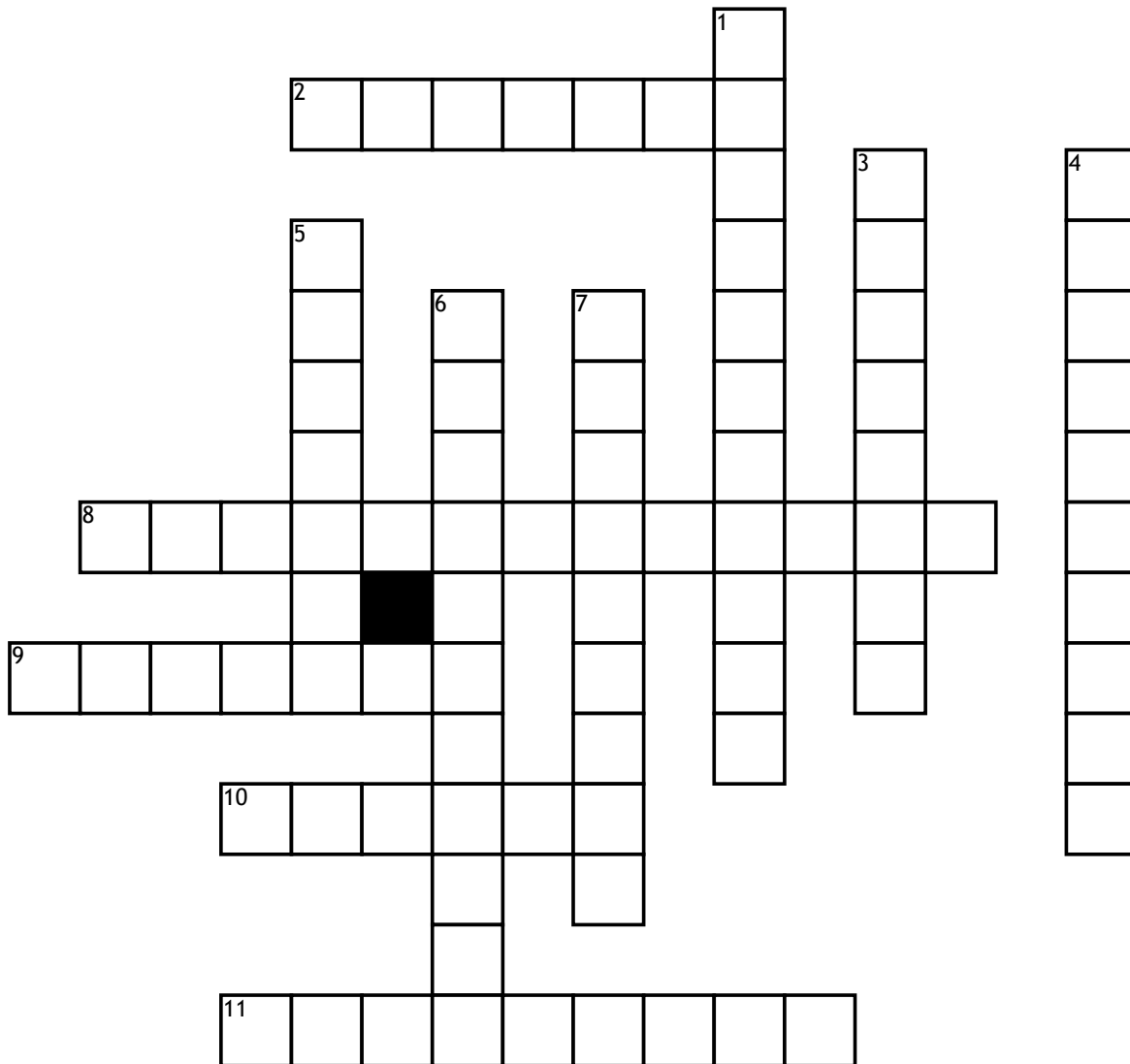


The formation of Sedimentary Rocks
