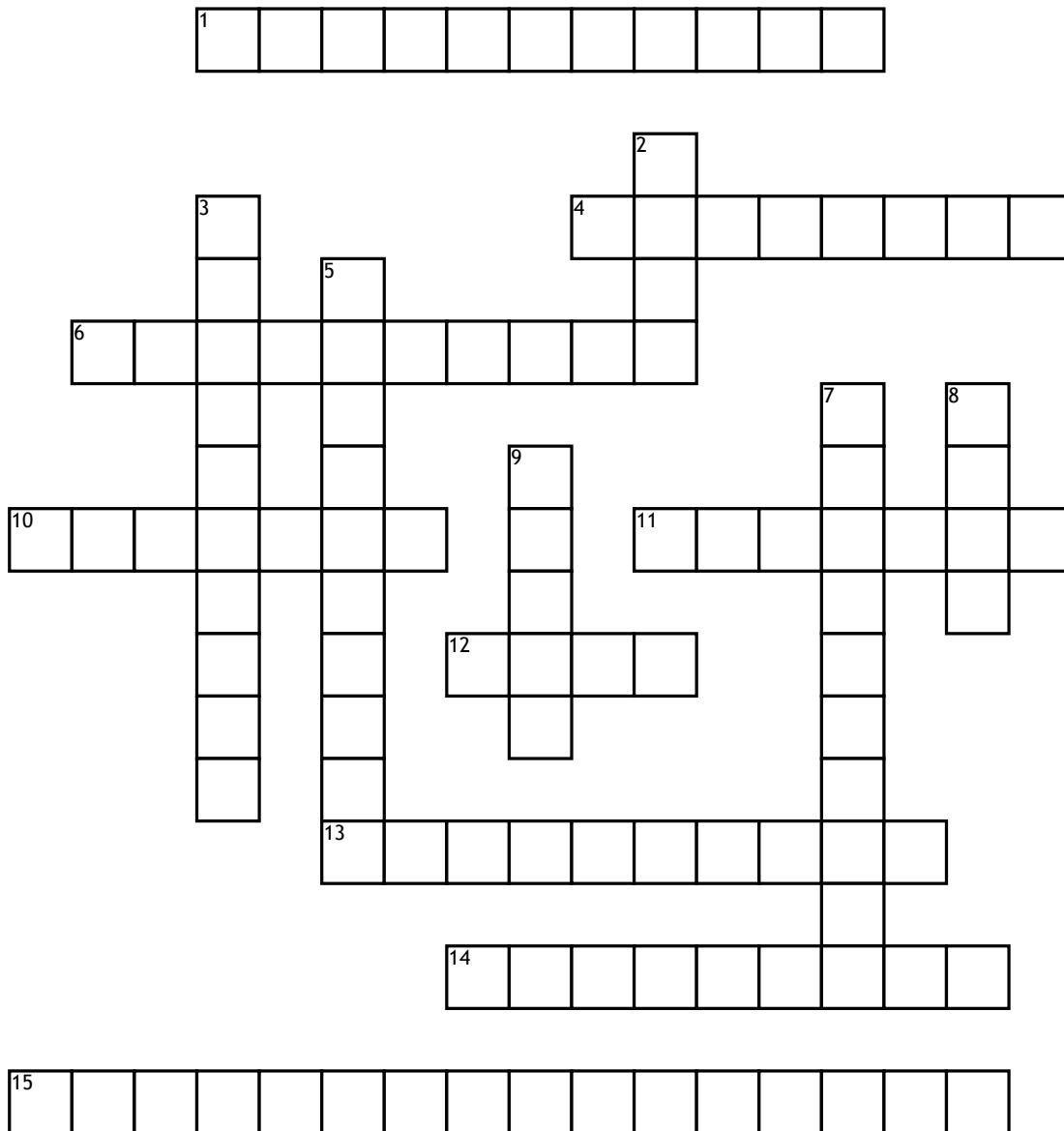


The road not traveled by Robert Frost
