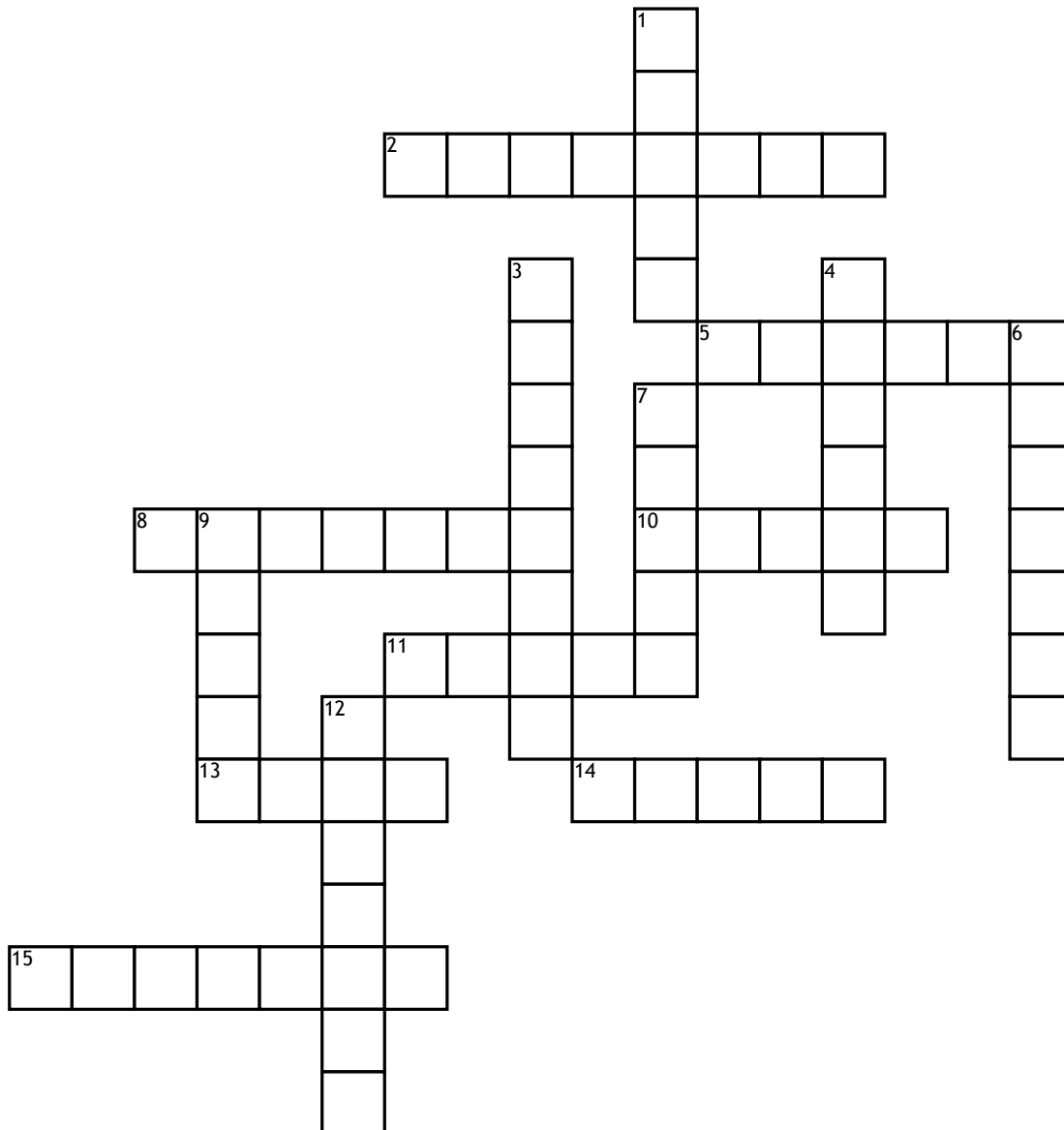


The structure and function of body organs



Across

2. Top part of the small intestine
 5. Protects foetus until birth
 8. Lies centrally at front of the lower pelvis
 10. This organ is found on the right side beneath the diaphragm
 11. This organ is made of nervous tissue and contains neurons and neuroglia

13. Covers the whole body
 14. An organ responsible for pumping blood to the lungs and around the body
 15. Produce ova and secrete hormones

1. Where nutrients are absorbed into the bloodstream
 3. Organ which secretes insulin and glucagon

4. Produce spermatozoa and secrete hormones
 6. This organ churns and mixes food into chyme
 7. Absorbs water, producing semi-solid faeces
 9. This organ is found on either side of the heart
 12. Composed of nephrons
