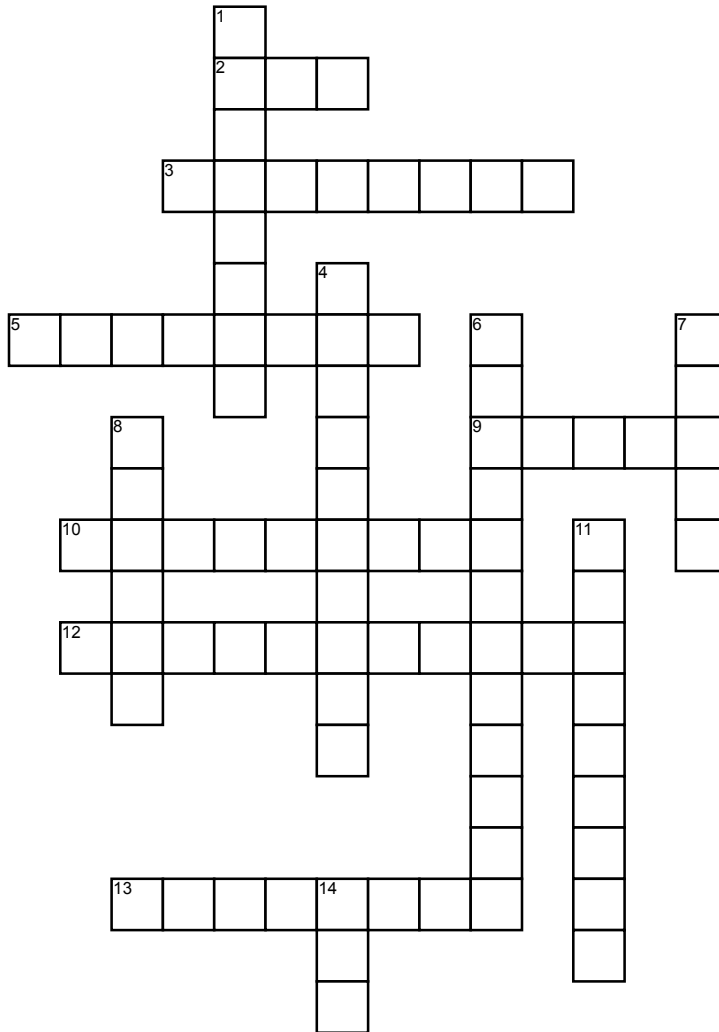

4. Part of theater in which the audience sits

6. In charge of everything backstage

11. Type of monologue in which a character directly addresses an audience or speaks his thoughts aloud and alone.

14. An instruction given by the Stage Manager to one of the technical departments to take some action.
