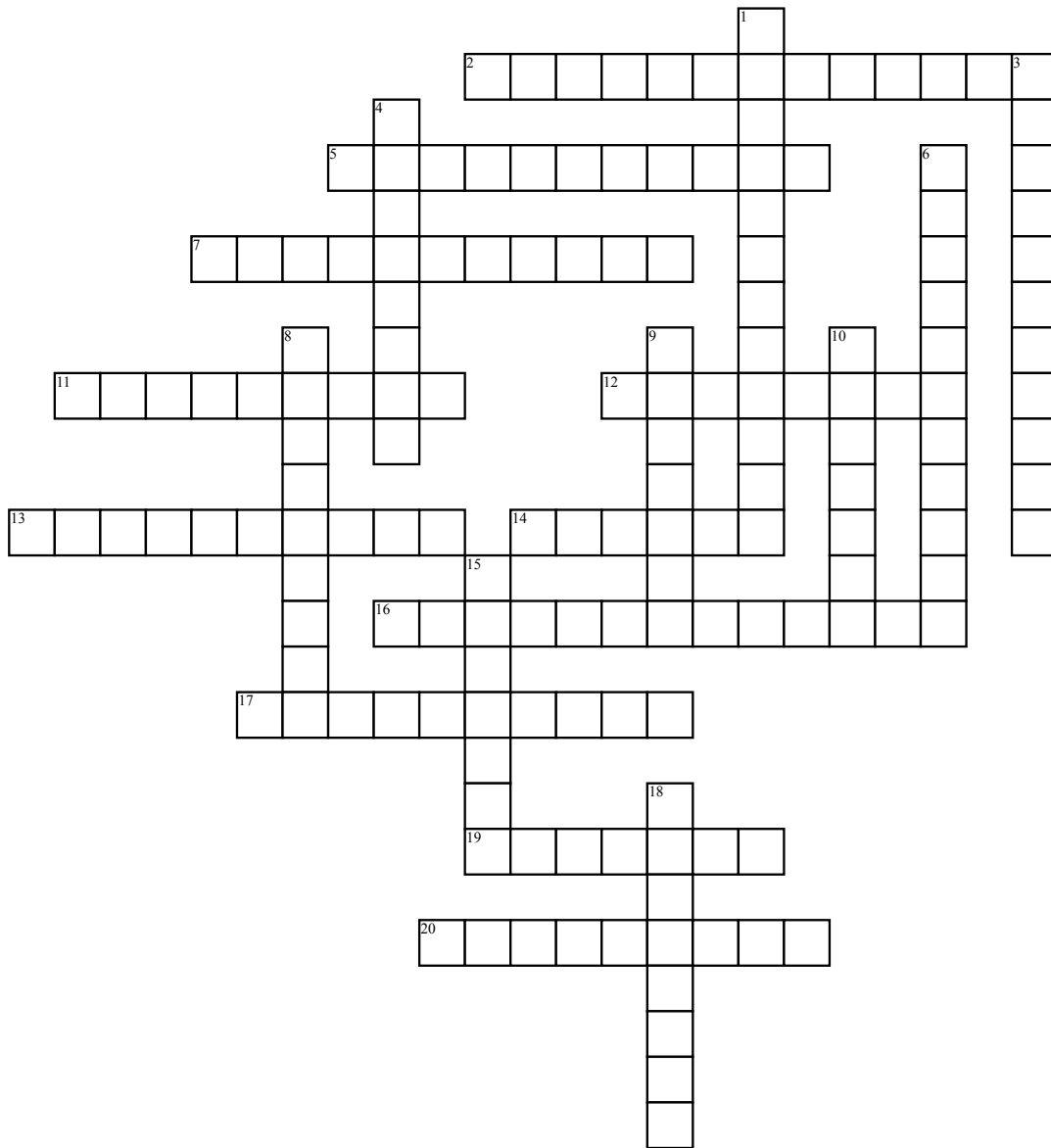


Theology—Apostles Crossword

- 2. Greek Tradition holds he was martyred
- 5. the custom of blessing houses with holy water. Also revered as a saint in Eastern Christianity
- 7. First Greek pope (Once erroneously split into Cletus and Anacletus)
- 11. First to abdicate after exile to Sardinia by Emperor Maximinus Thrax
- 12. Converted Berber/ Known for excommunicating Theodotus of Byzantium
- 13. First pope from Syria

- 14. Decreed that Easter should only be celebrated on a Sunday.
- 16. Church Father St. Irenaeus called him a great martyr.
- 17. Imperial Roman pope, Sometimes called Felix II, Great-great-grandfather of pope Gregory I.
- 19. Declared that marriage was valid as a sacrament blessed by a priest
- 20. Greek. Tradition holds he was martyred; feast day 11 January.

- 3. Roman (Banished from Rome under Maxentius)
- 4. Roman. Divided the communities of Rome into seven districts, each supervised by a deacon.
- 6. Converted Jew. Said to have divided Rome into parishes, assigning a priest to each
- 8. which is said to be the basis of apostolic authority for the clergy. Also revered as a saint in Eastern Christianity
- 9. First pope from Croatia
- 10. He received the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven
