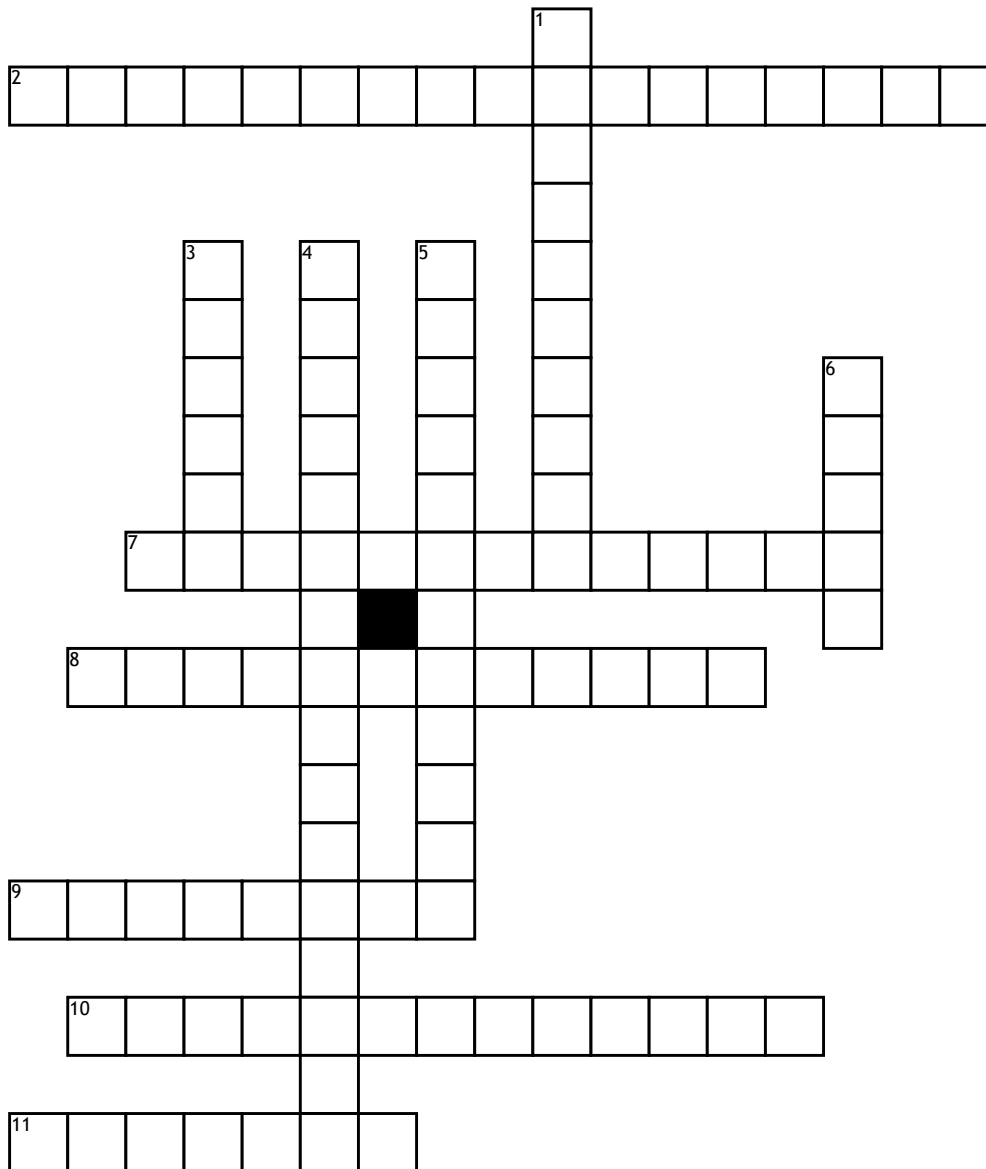

7. a temporary place where God would meet with Moses as the Israelites journeyed in the desert; usually pitched outside of the camp (3 words)
8. the place where Adam and Eve lived before the fall (3 words)
9. people who mediated between God and the kings of Israel; they were often killed as a result
10. led and guided the Israelites during the day as they travelled through the desert (3 words)
11. people responsible for the temple; came from the tribe of Levi

1. a place of worship built according to God's specifications in Exodus which was used while in the desert
3. the permanent place where God's people would come to worship and offer sacrifices
4. a box containing the tablets of the Mosaic law, manna, and the rod of Aaron; was stolen at one time by the Philistines (4 words)
5. was located inside the answer in 5 down and 1 down and could only be entered into by the high priest; the curtain separating this place was torn in two when Jesus died on the cross (3 words)
