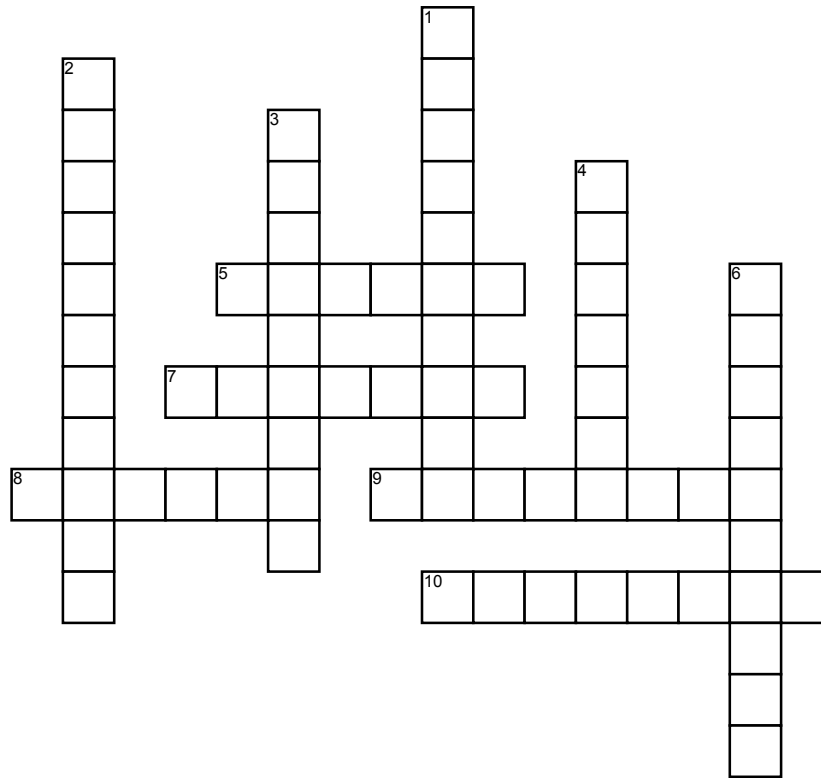


Three skeleton keys
