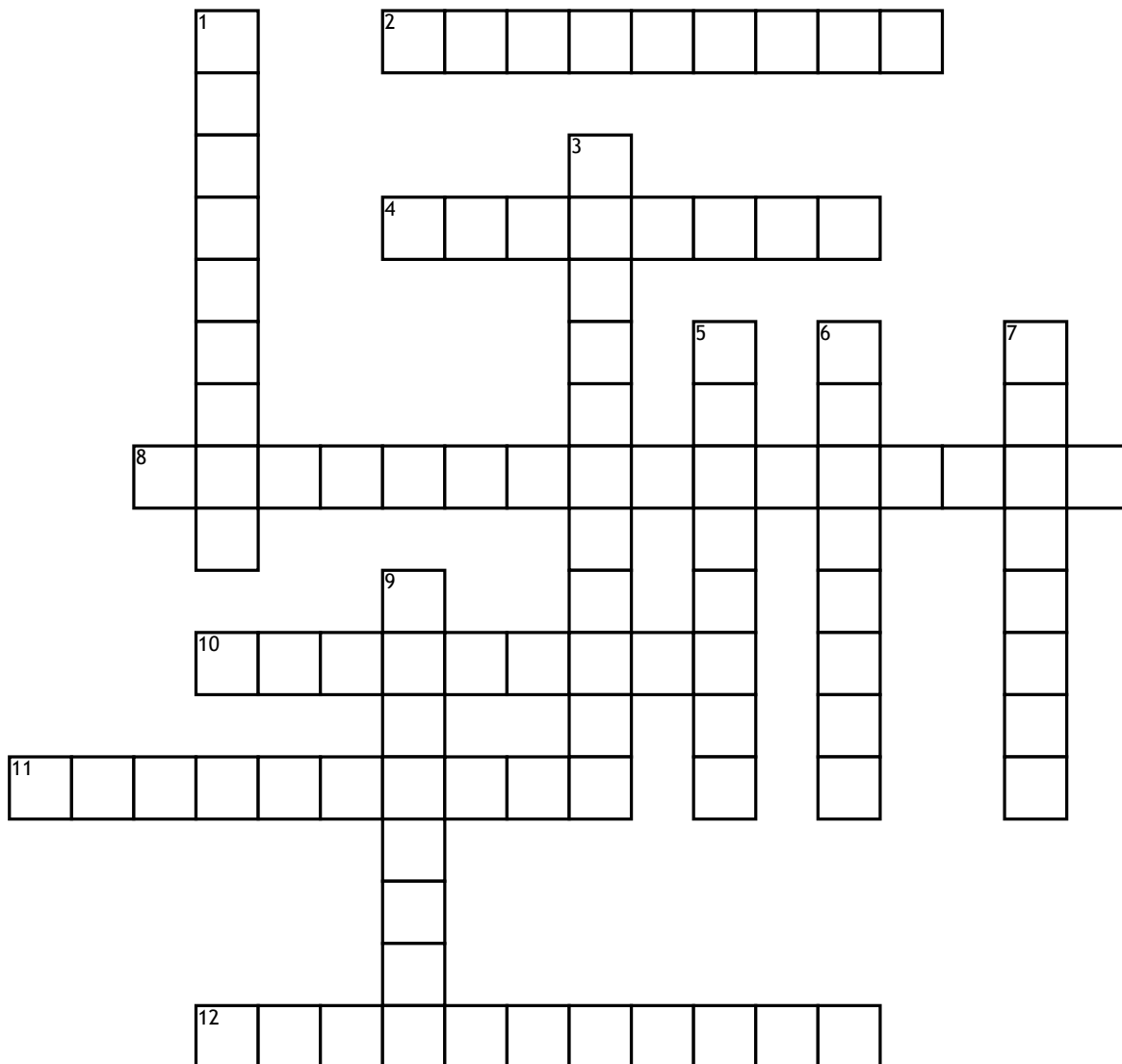


Tissues Vocabulary Crossword
