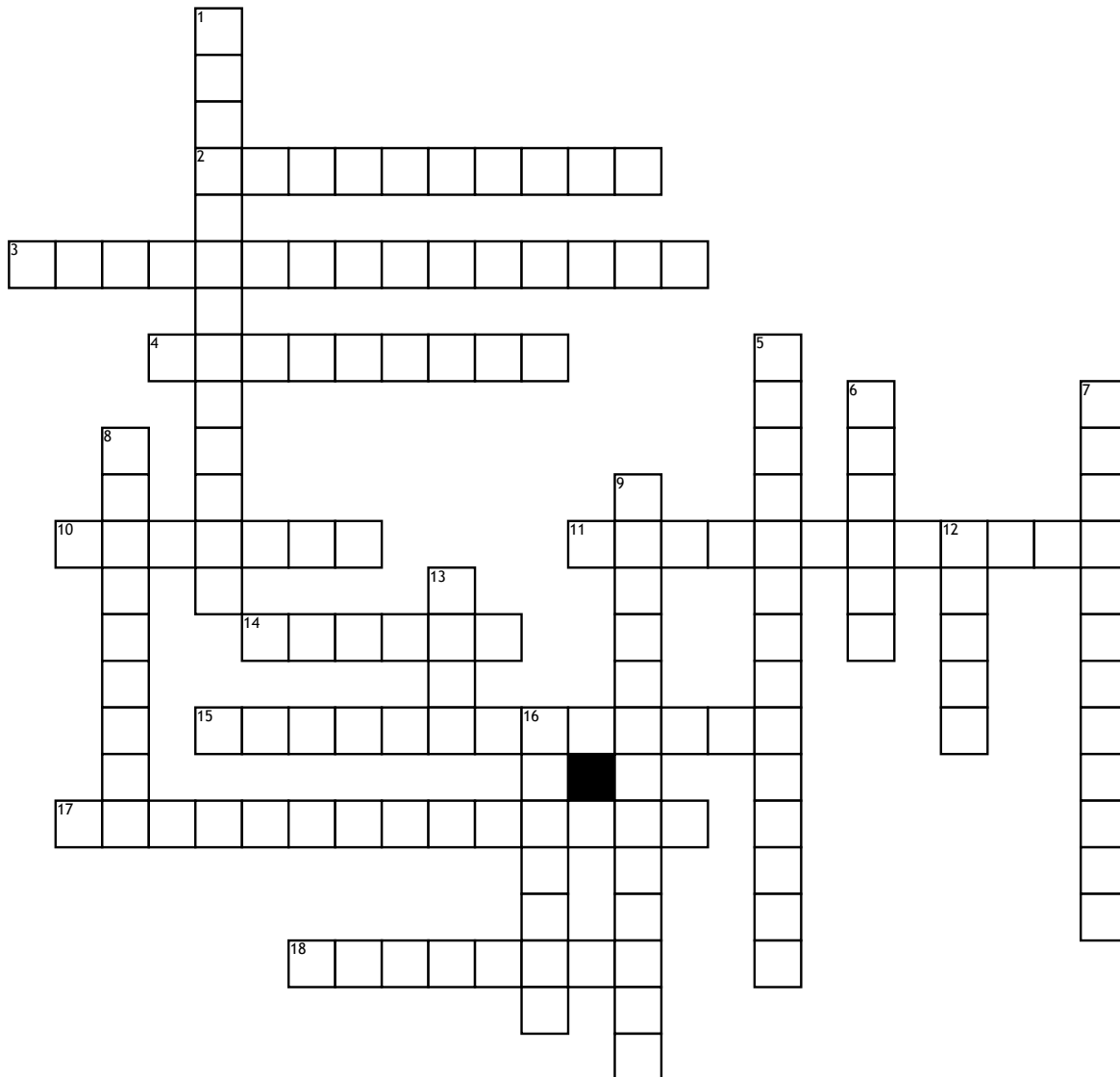

3. maps that show the topography of the land, using contour lines

4. physical features of the Earth's surface found in a given region

10. physical features of land

11. a group of mountain ranges and systems

14. Variation or change in the elevation of land terrain

15. areas of flat land along sea coasts that are low in elevation

17. areas of flat land that are found inland and are usually higher in elevation than coastal plains

18. a landform that rises more than 600 meters (2,000 feet) above its surrounding landscape with steep slopes and a peak

6. areas of extensive flat land that do not rise far above sea level

7. markings on topographic maps that show elevation, steep slopes, and lines that are farther apart to show less steep areas

8. height above sea level

9. group of mountains that were formed in the same way at the same time

12. a table-like landform like a mesa, but smaller and also a result of erosion

13. a large, table-like landform that is the result of plateau erosion

16. an extensive, raised, flat-surfaced area that has slopes or cliffs on one or more sides. They rise 600-1500 meters above sea level, extending for many miles with little relief
