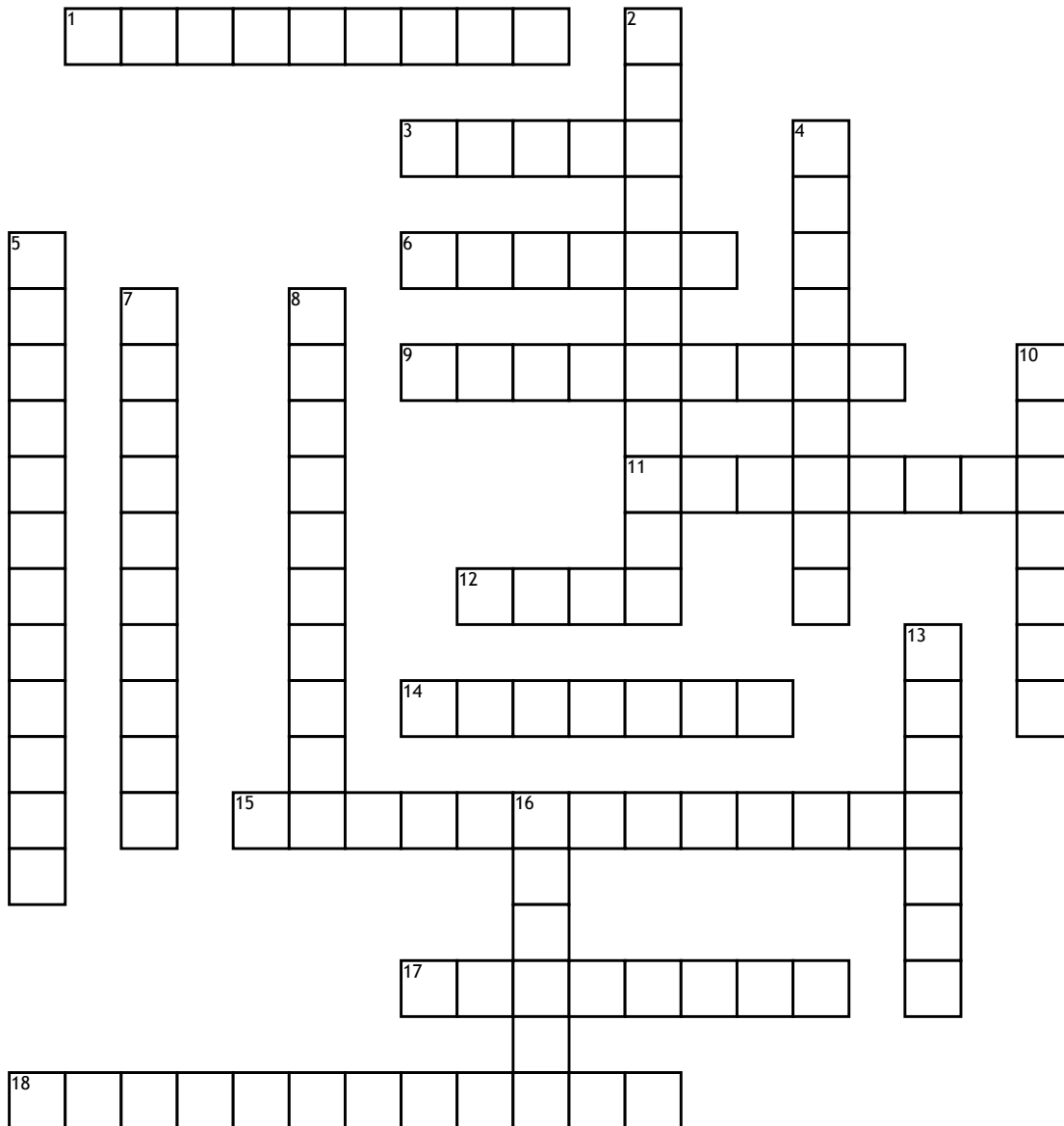


Trents Book Report-Puzzle
