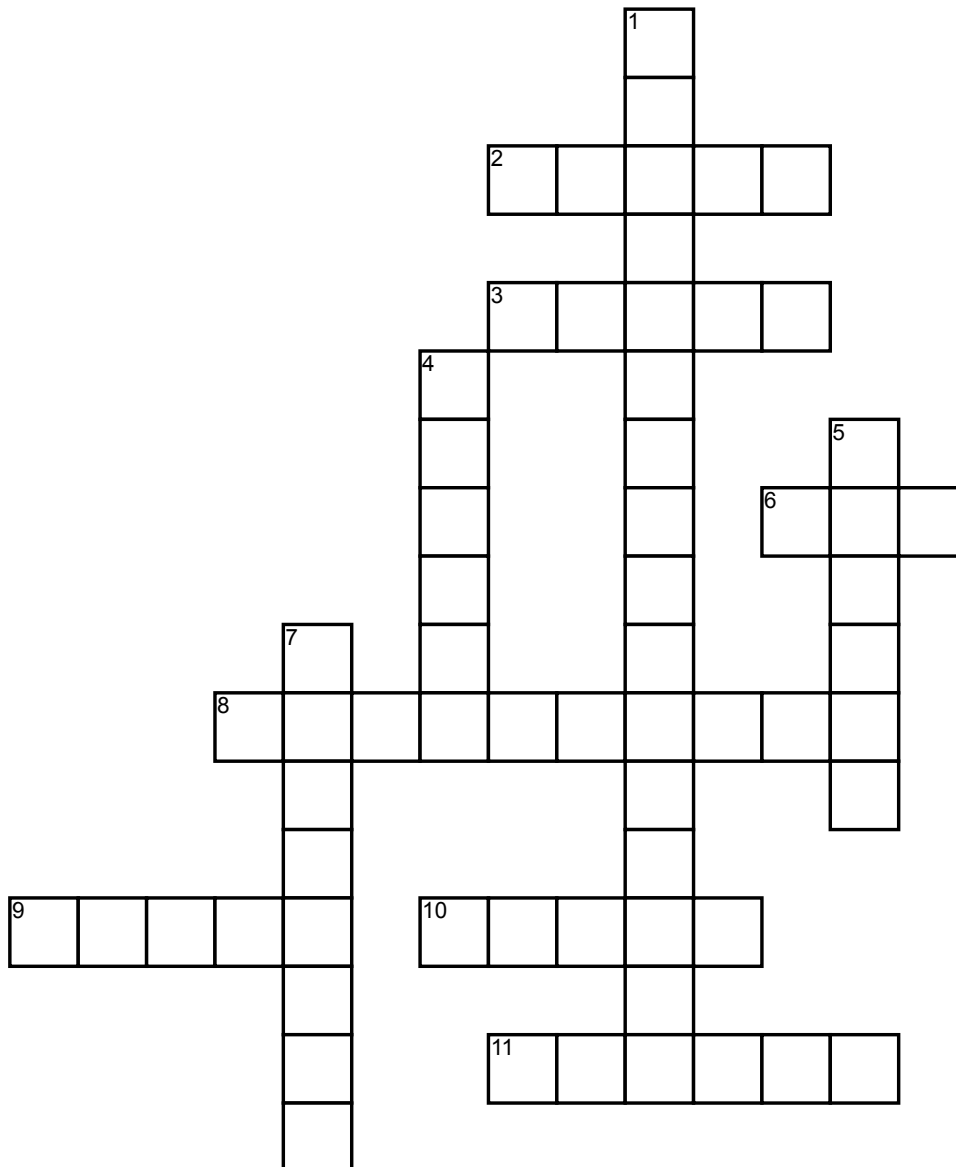


Trimester 2: Landforms

2. land built up by deposits of sand and silt at the mouth of some rivers
 3. a broad, flat or gently rolling area; usually low in elevation.
 6. a wall built across a stream or river to hold back water
 8. a sudden and violent shaking of the ground
 9. A high, steep slope of rock or soil
 10. An area of land largely enclosed by higher land

11. narrow valley with steep sides; usually created by erosion
