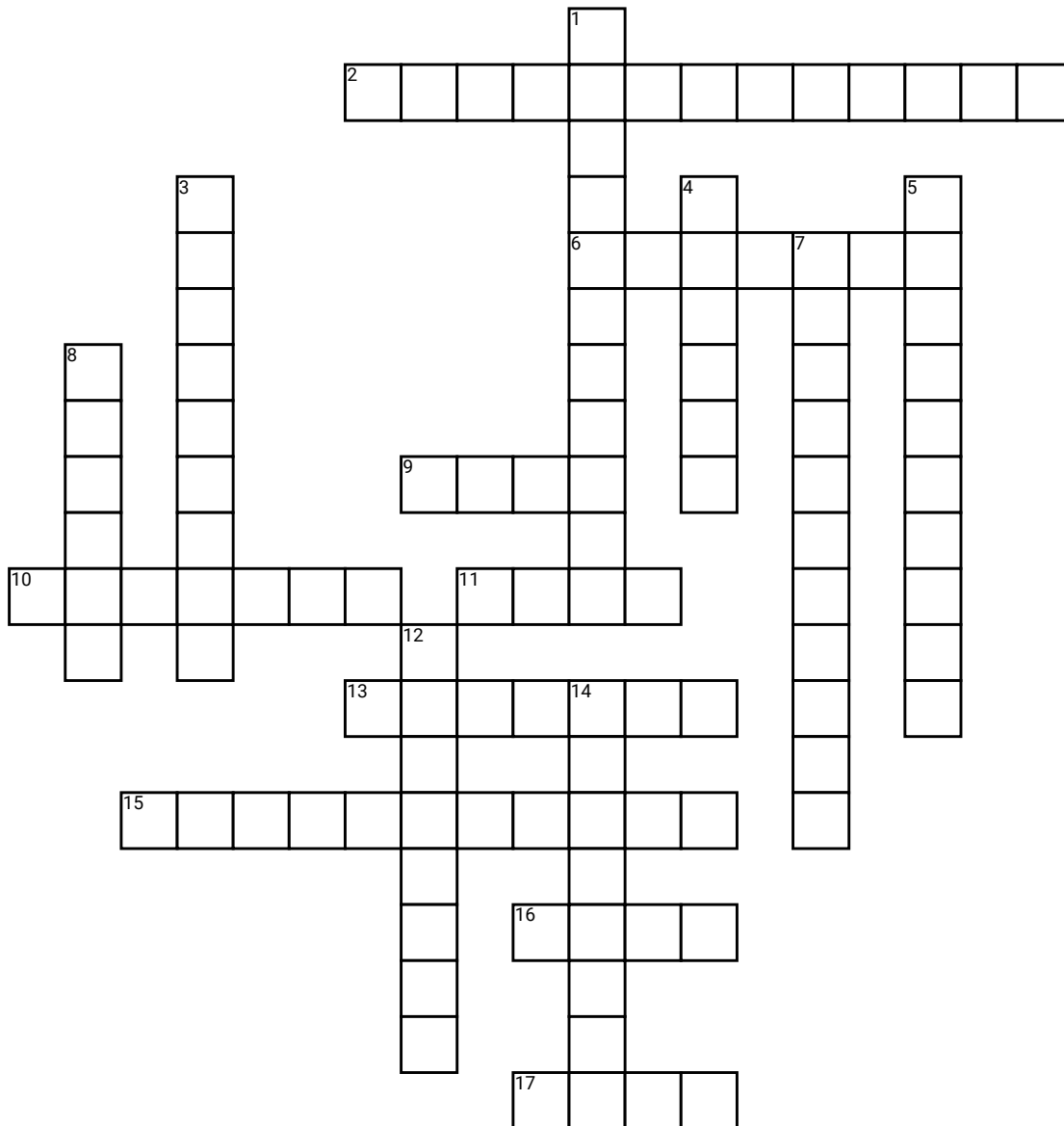

2. the skill or the work of arranging text and pictures, especially in the production of books, magazines, and websites (B1)
 6. the degree to which something is opaque/NOT transparent (C1)
 9. to remove some or all of the edges from a picture, leaving only the most important part (C1)
 10. to produce or create art, music, poetry, or formal writing (B2)
 11. the system of colour printing that uses four colors of ink; cyan, magenta, yellow, black (C1)
 13. (the art of making) a picture in which various materials or objects, for example paper, cloth, or photographs, are stuck onto a larger surface (C1)
 15. a person who draws pictures, especially for books or magazines (C1)

16. written text that is to be printed, usually for sales/advertising purposes (B2)
 17. to make changes, deciding what will be removed and what will be kept in, in order to prepare a creative work for publishing (B2)

 1. the activity or job of taking photographs or filming (A2)
 3. A document to be printed with the longer side of the paper at the top and bottom (B2).
 4. the way that something is designed or arranged, specifically print material: book and magazine pages (C1)
 5. the style and size of the letters used in printing or on screen composition (C2)

7. a picture or diagram or a group of pictures or diagrams showing or explaining information (C2)
 8. a sign, shape, or object that is used to represent something else (B2)
 12. A document to be printed with the shorter side of the paper at the top and bottom (B2)
 14. "digital canvas" on which graphic designers create digital artworks (C1)
