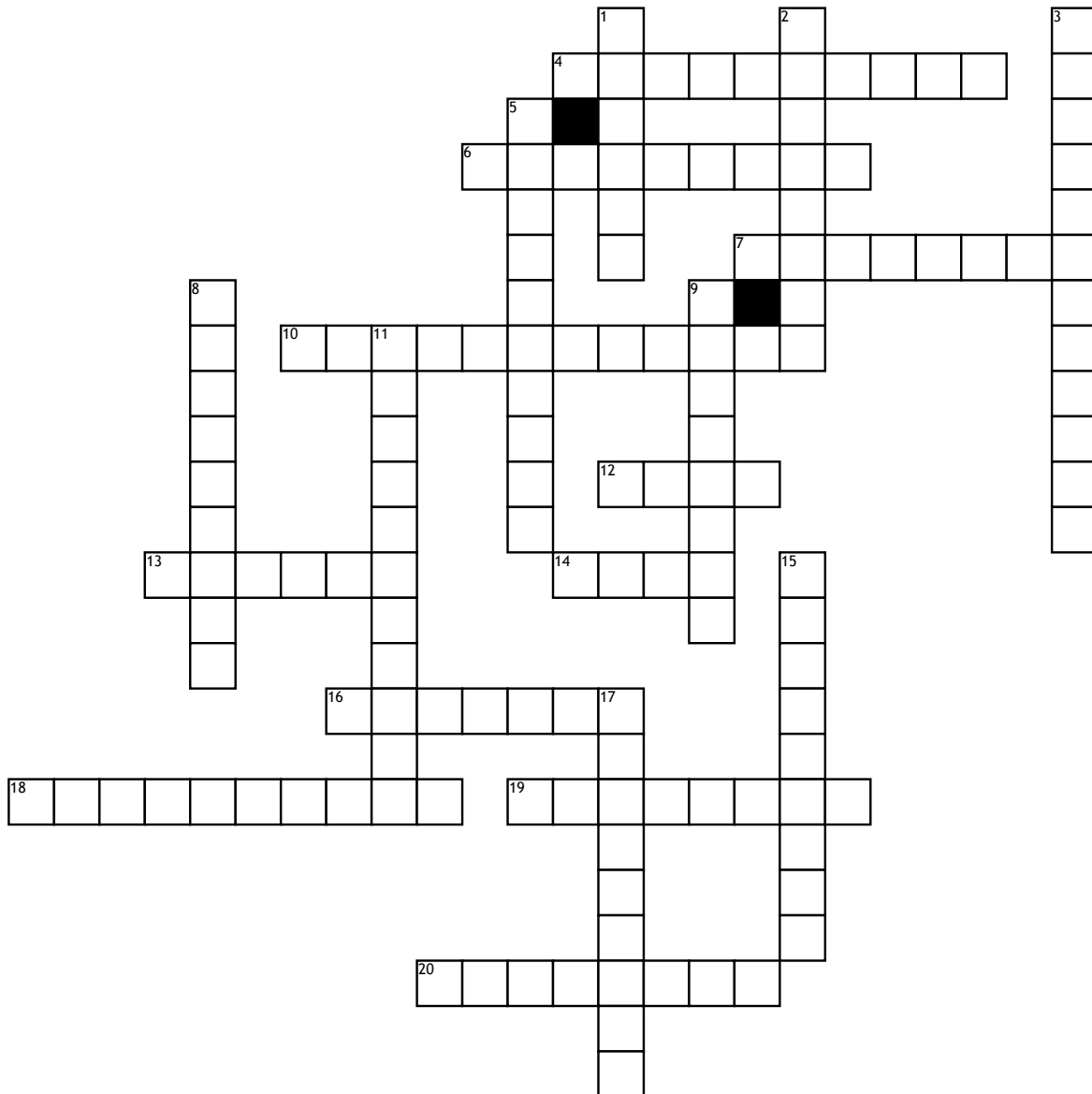


# Two Of A Kind Vocabulary Crossword
