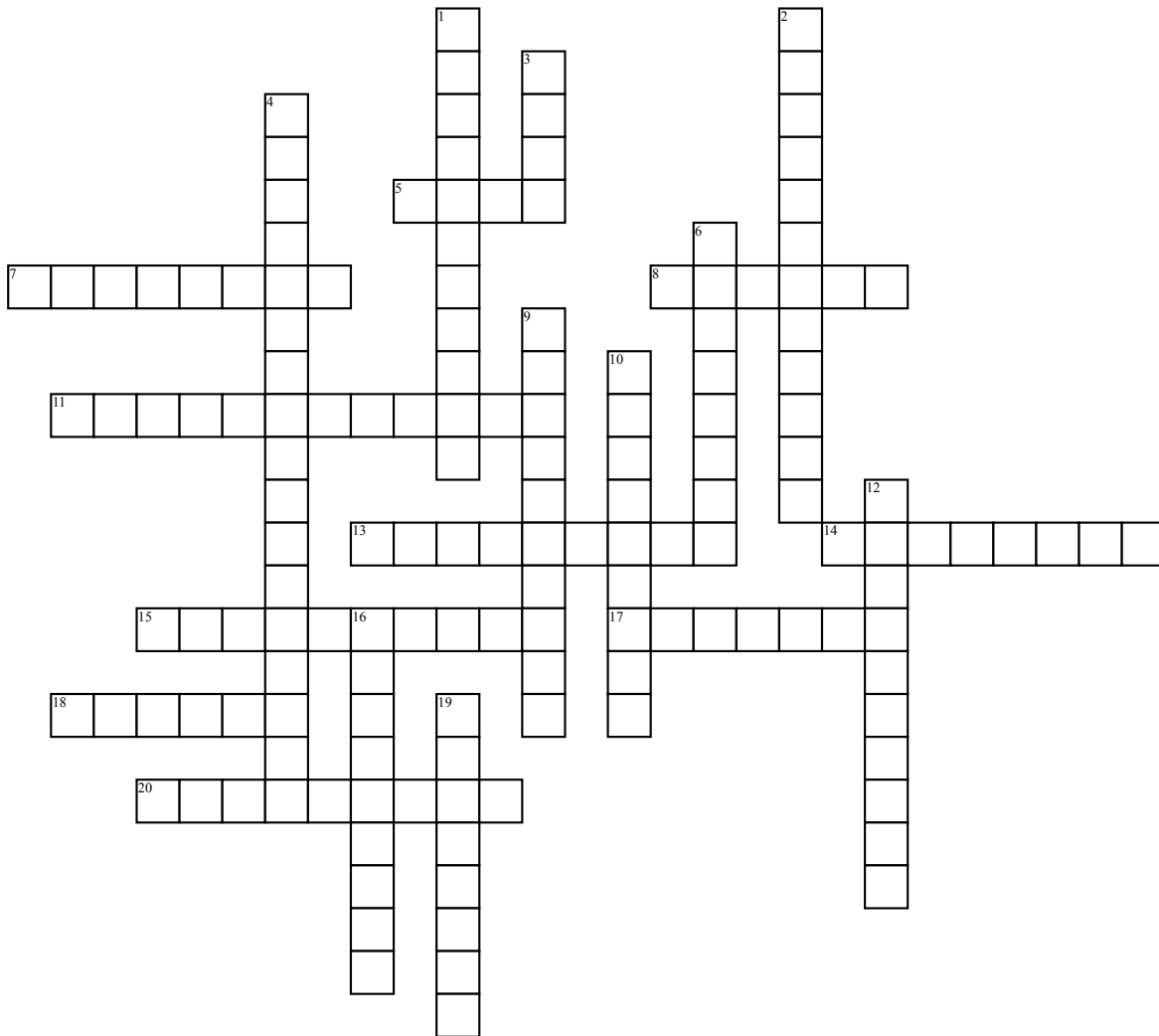


Two of a kind
