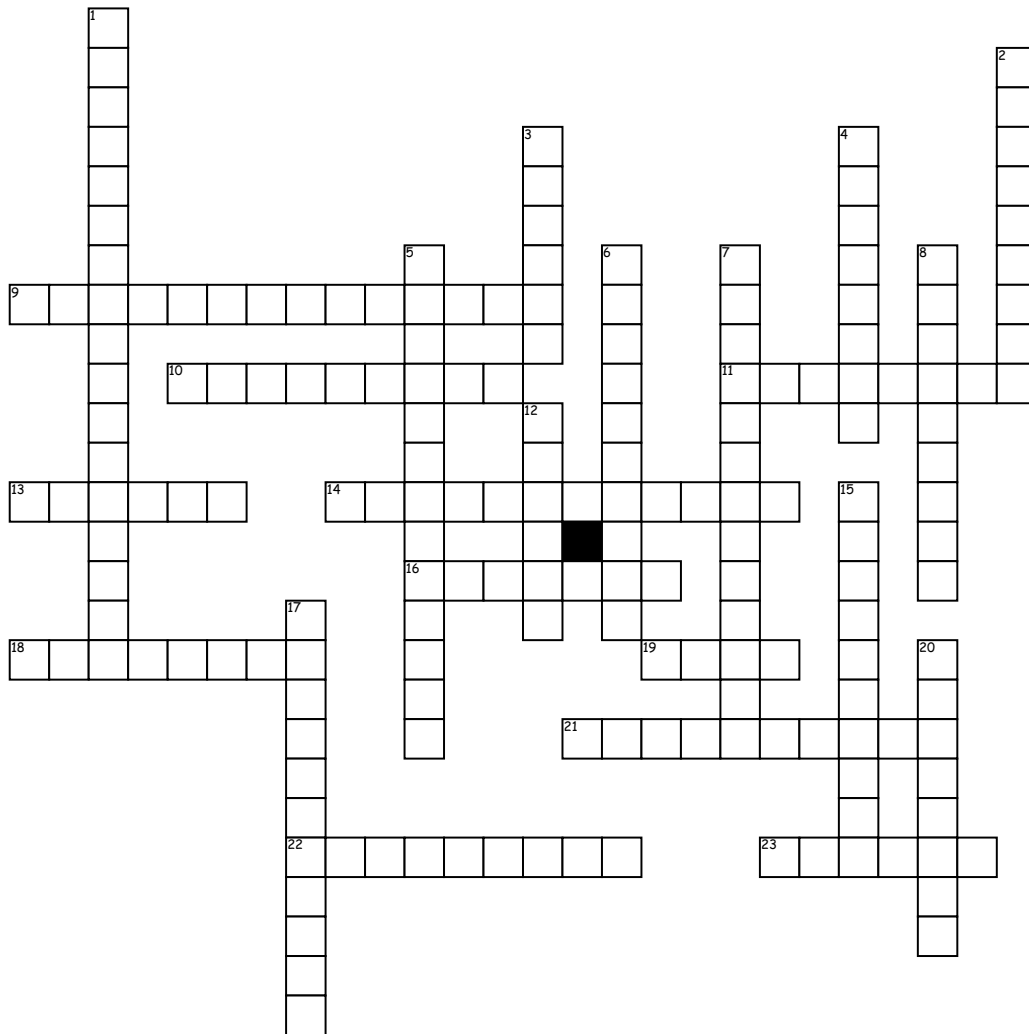


# Types of Government
