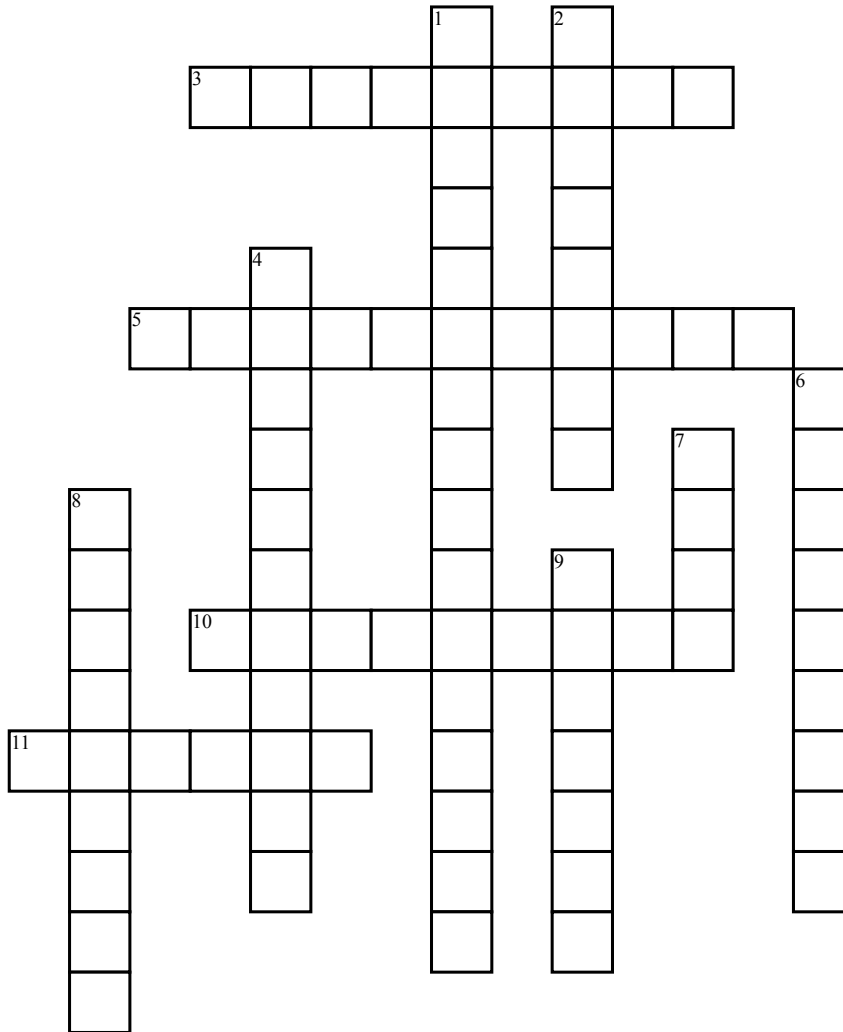


Types of laws
