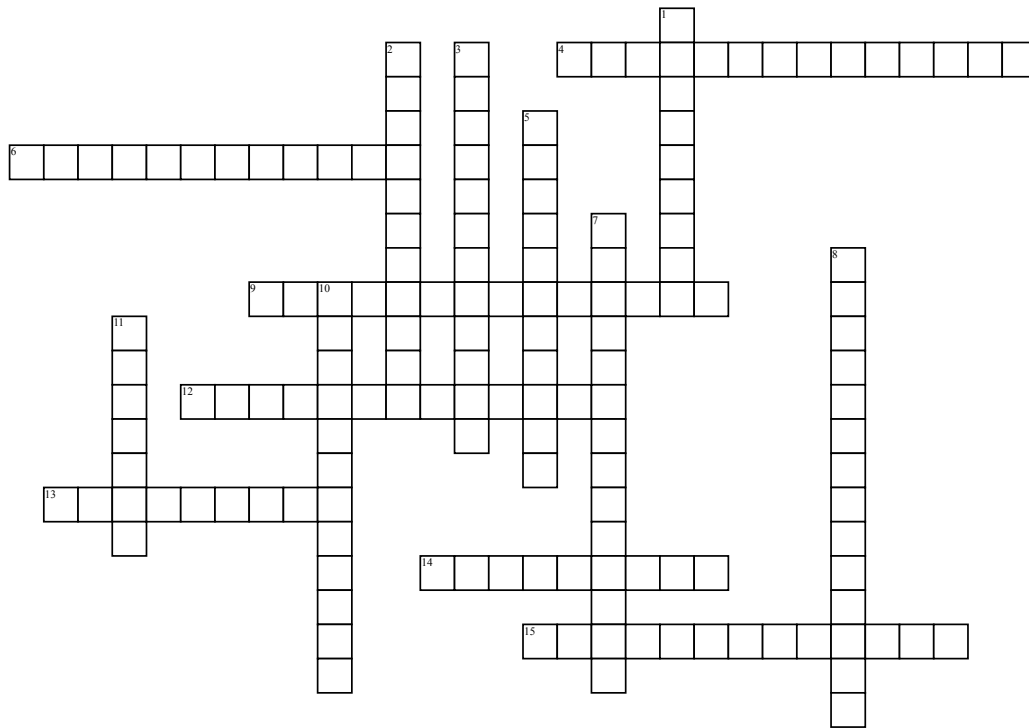


# US GOV CROSSWORD PUZZLE.
