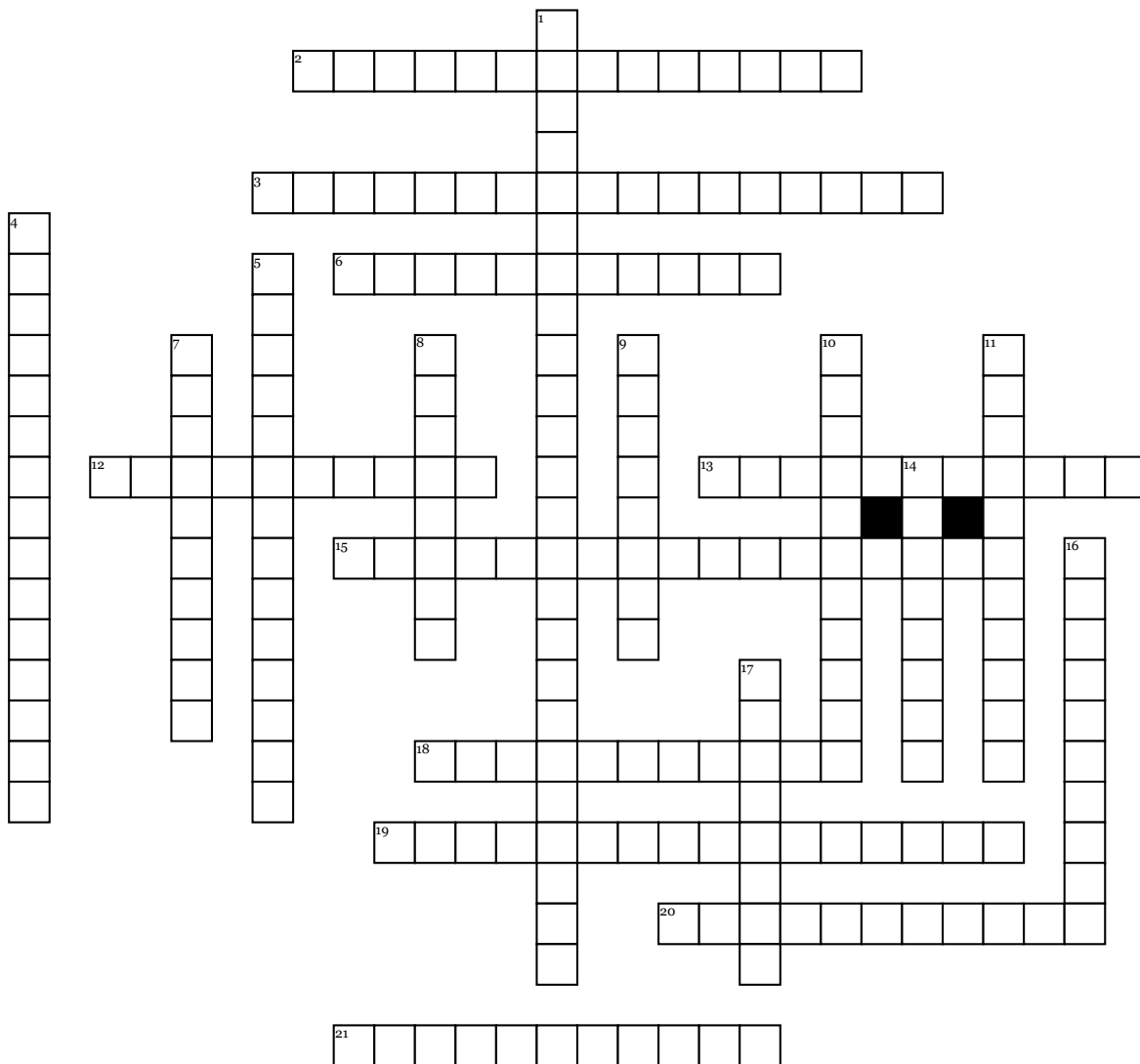


U.S History Crossword Puzzle

- 1. An executive order issued on January 1, 1863, by president Lincoln freeing slaves in all portions of the United States not then under Union control.

 - 5. a series of violent civil confrontations in the United States between 1854 and 1861 which emerged from a political and ideological debate over the legality of slavery
