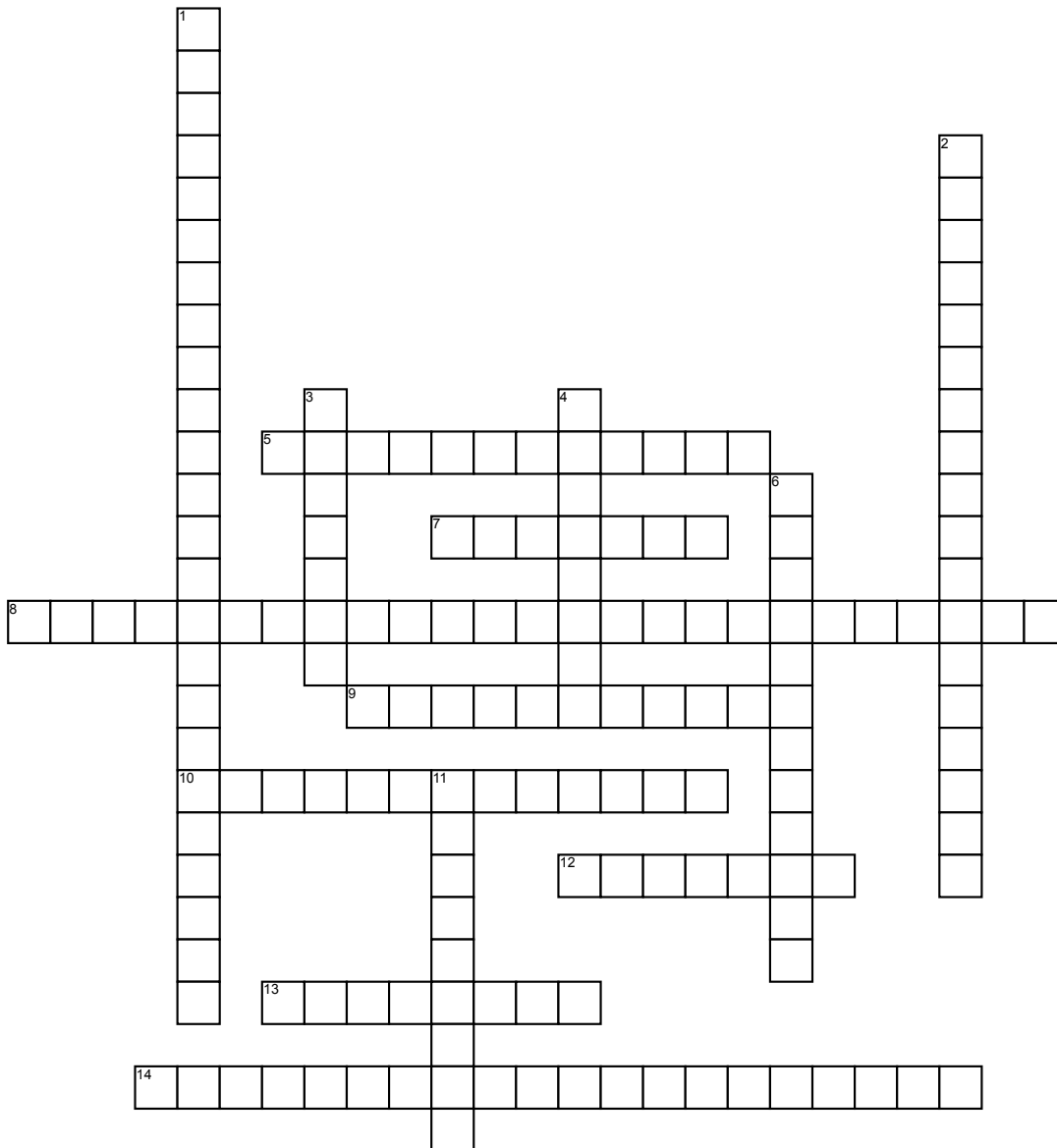

9. A pamphlet published in 1776 by Thomas Paine that persuaded many American colonists to support independence.

14. Passed by the British parliament declaring its power to legislate for the colonies "in all cases whatsoever".
