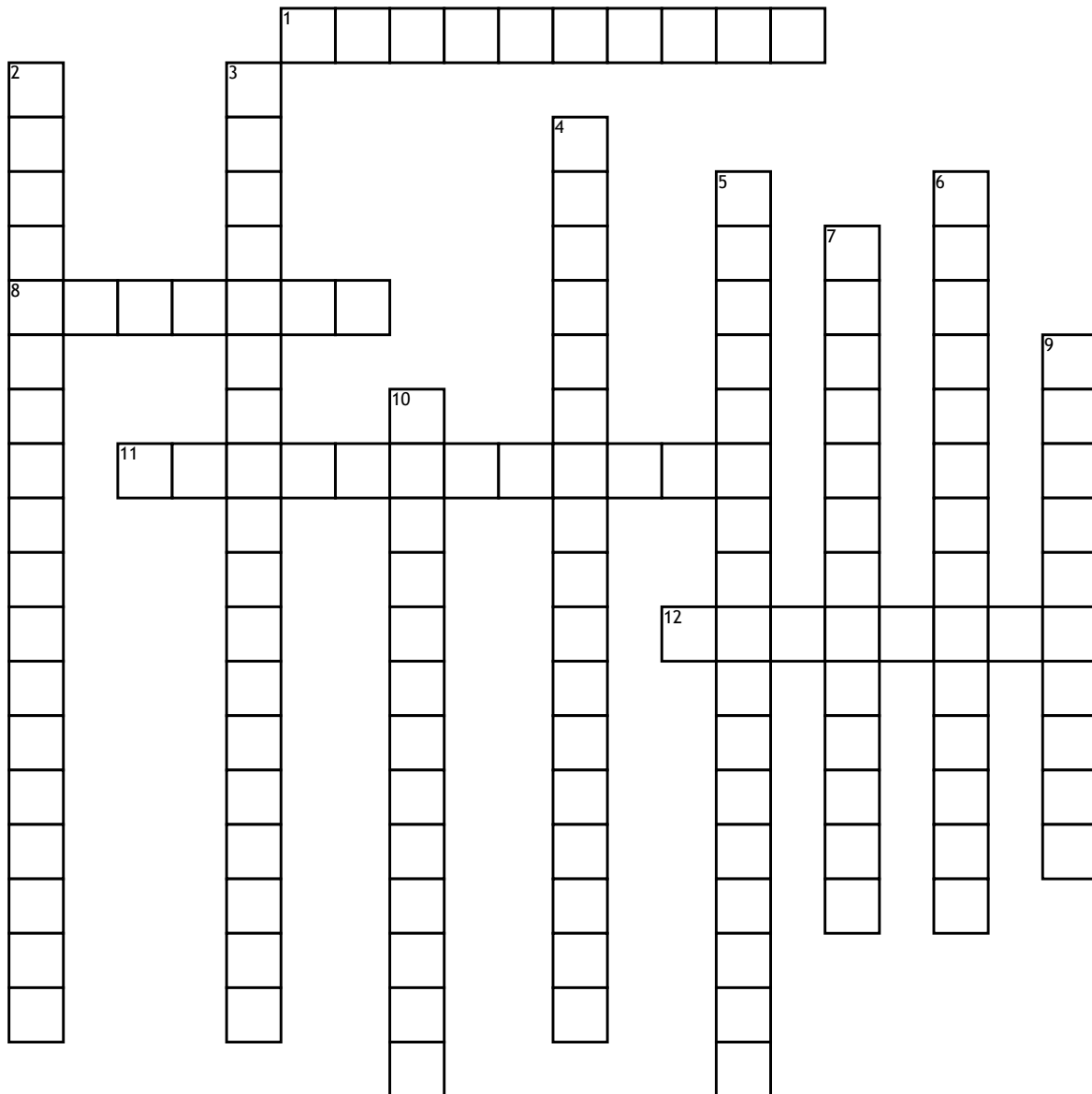


# U. S. Constitution



## Across

1. Powers of government are divided between the national government and state governments.
8. Personal freedoms, No tyrannical rule (1st Amendment Rights -> Religion/Speech/Press /Assembly/Petition)
11. Free enterprise/Government Hands Off Economy
12. Participation of the common people in government

## Down

2. The people hold supreme power, so the powers of the government come from the consent of the people
3. The power of the federal government is divided among three separate branches
4. To prevent any one branch from becoming too powerful, the Constitution gave each branch ways to stop the actions of the other branches
5. The powers of government are limited by the Constitution.

6. Everyone is sociably equal, no social status
7. Individuals are free to rise as high in society as their work takes them, or as low
9. The Constitution can be amended (altered), allowing it to adjust to changing times and attitudes
10. A republican form of government is a democratic government of representatives elected by the people
