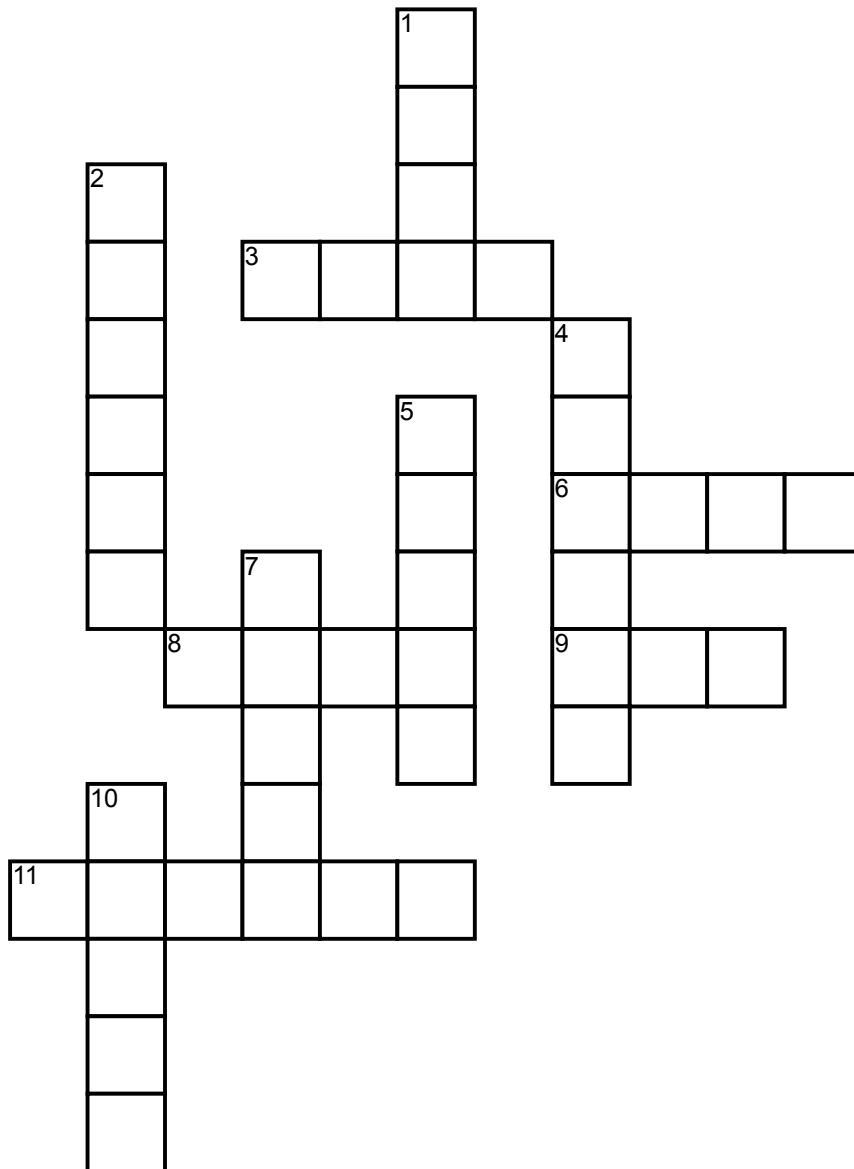

- 11. This part holds the strings down at the bottom of the ukulele

Down

- 1. The top of the ukulele, much like the top of your body
- 2. Where did the ukulele come from?
- 4. _____ pegs, used to tighten or loosen strings
- 5. Three or more pitches combined create this
- 7. _____ hole, in the middle of the body
- 10. Sections divided into lines on the neck
