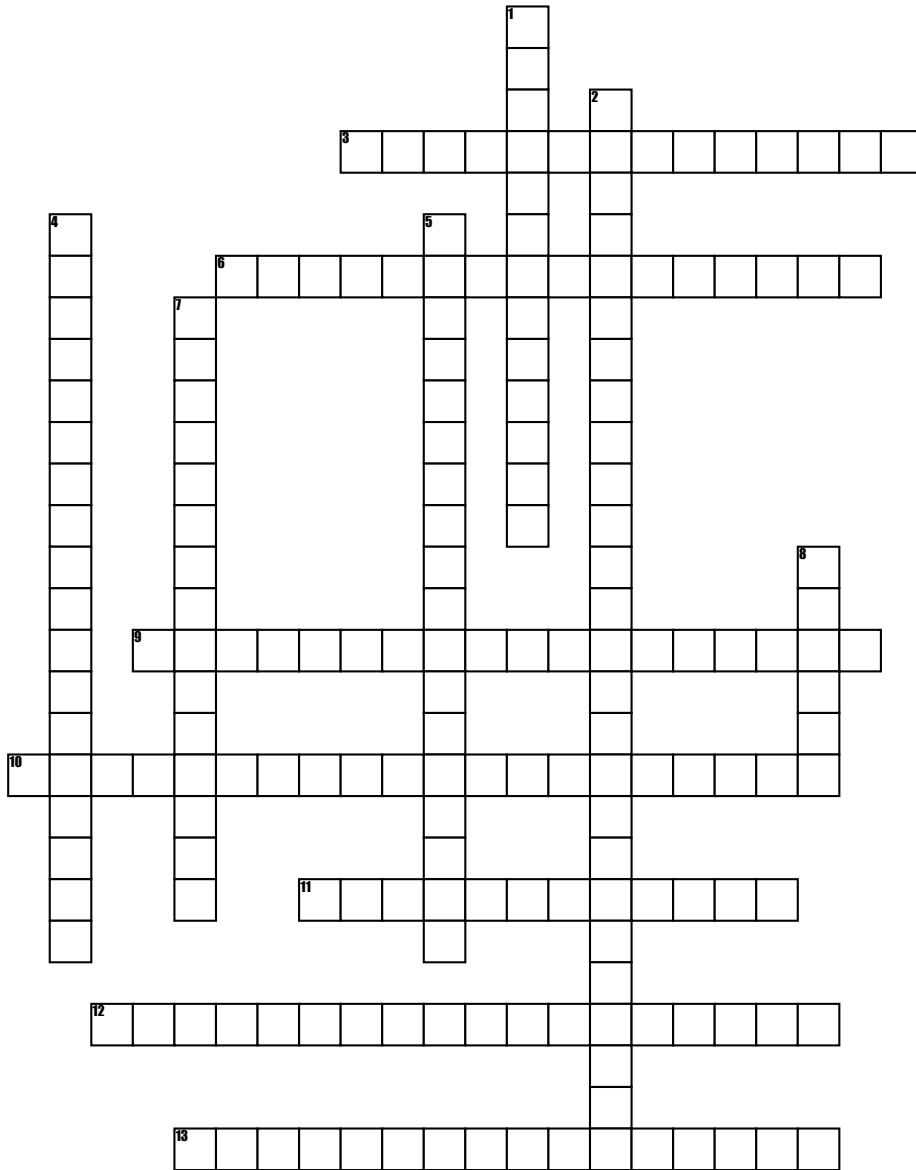

**3.** A novel, first published serially, by Harriet Beecher Stowe; it paints a grim picture of life under slavery.

**6.** A set of laws, passed in the midst of fierce wrangling between groups favoring slavery and groups opposing it, that attempted to give something to both sides.

**9.** act passed in 1854 that created the Kansa and Nebraska territories and abolished the Missouri compromise by allowing settlers to determine whether slavery would be allowed in the new territories

**10.** , murder of five men from a proslavery settlement on Pottawatomie Creek,

**11.** excessive regard for sectional or local interests; regional or local spirit, prejudice, etc.

**12.** an act of Congress (1820) by which Missouri was admitted as a slave state, Maine as a free state, and slavery was prohibited in the Louisiana Purchase

**13.** a law passed as part of the compromise of 1850 which provided southern slaveholders with legal weapons to capture slaves who had escaped to the free states

**1.** a former u.s. political party (1848-56) that opposed the extention of slavery in the territories not amitted

**2.** A nation existing from 1861-1865, consisting of the eleven Southern states who sought independence from the United States of America over the issue of slavery and states' rights.

**4.** proposal made in 1846 to prohibit slavery in the territory added to the united states as a result of the Mexican-American war

**5.** The idea that the government authority comes from the people

**7.** one of two main political parties in the united states

**8.** to withdraw formally from an alliance, federation, or association, as from a political union, a religious organization, etc.
