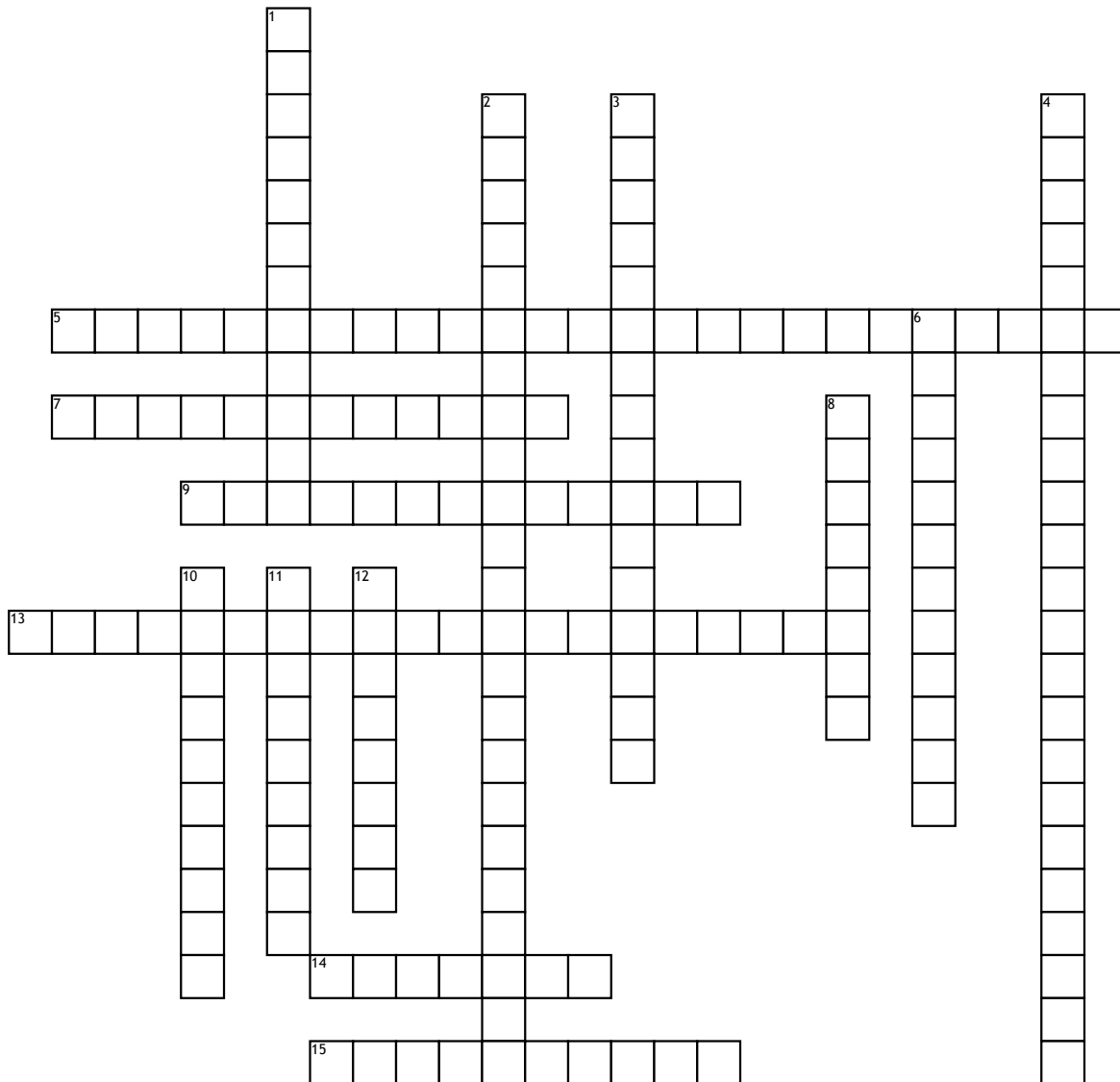


Unit 21: Alcohol Use
