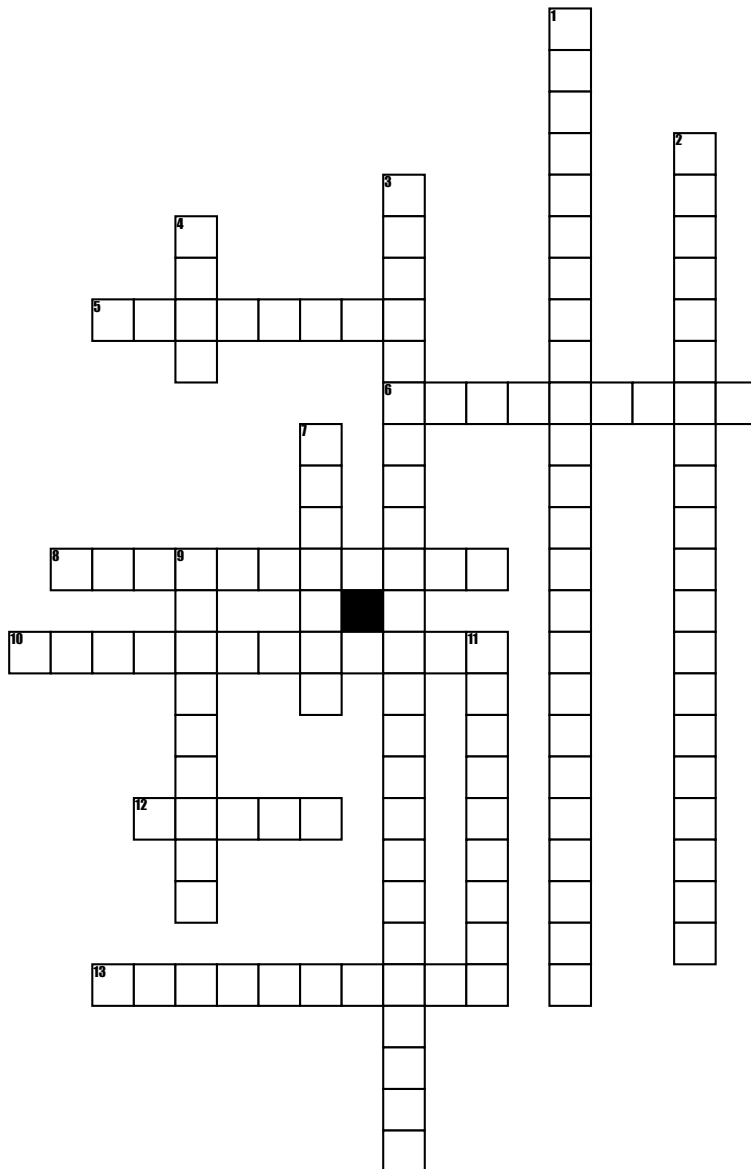


# Unit 2: Concept 6 Vocabulary
