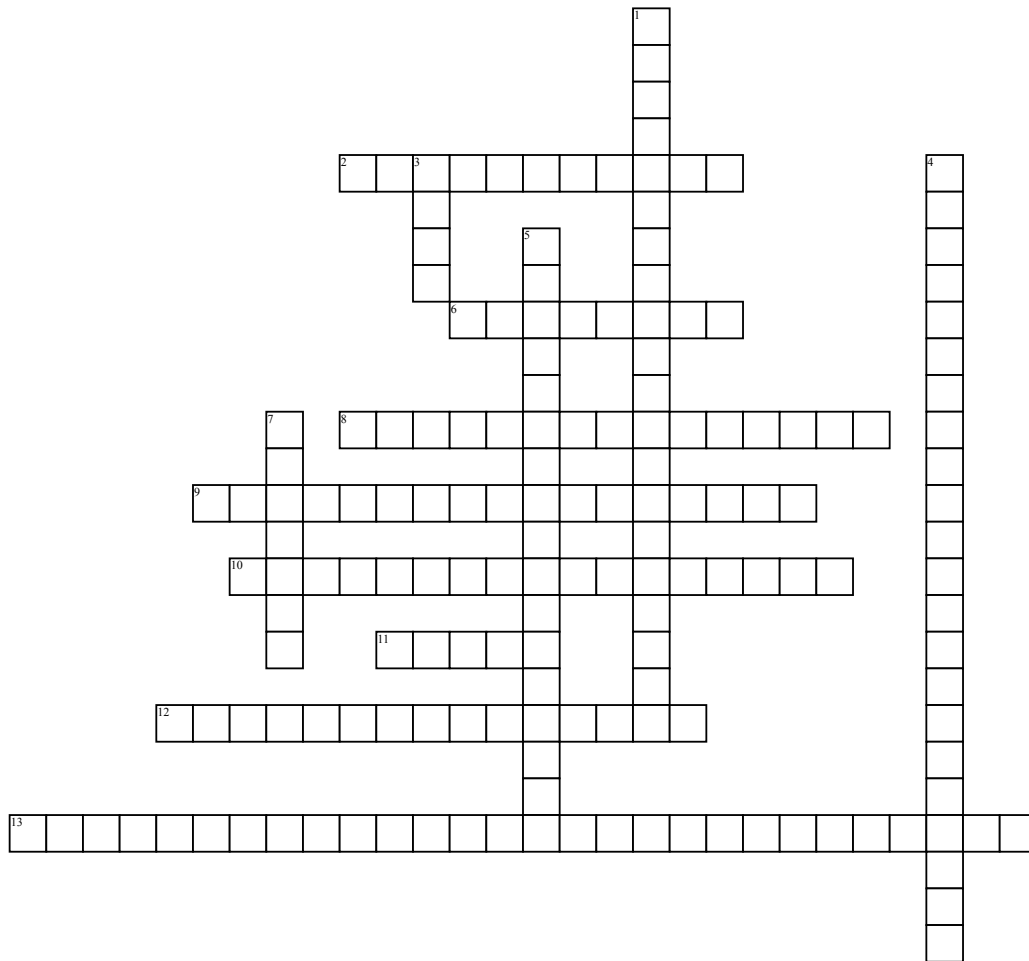


# Unit 2 Lesson 1 Vocabulary
