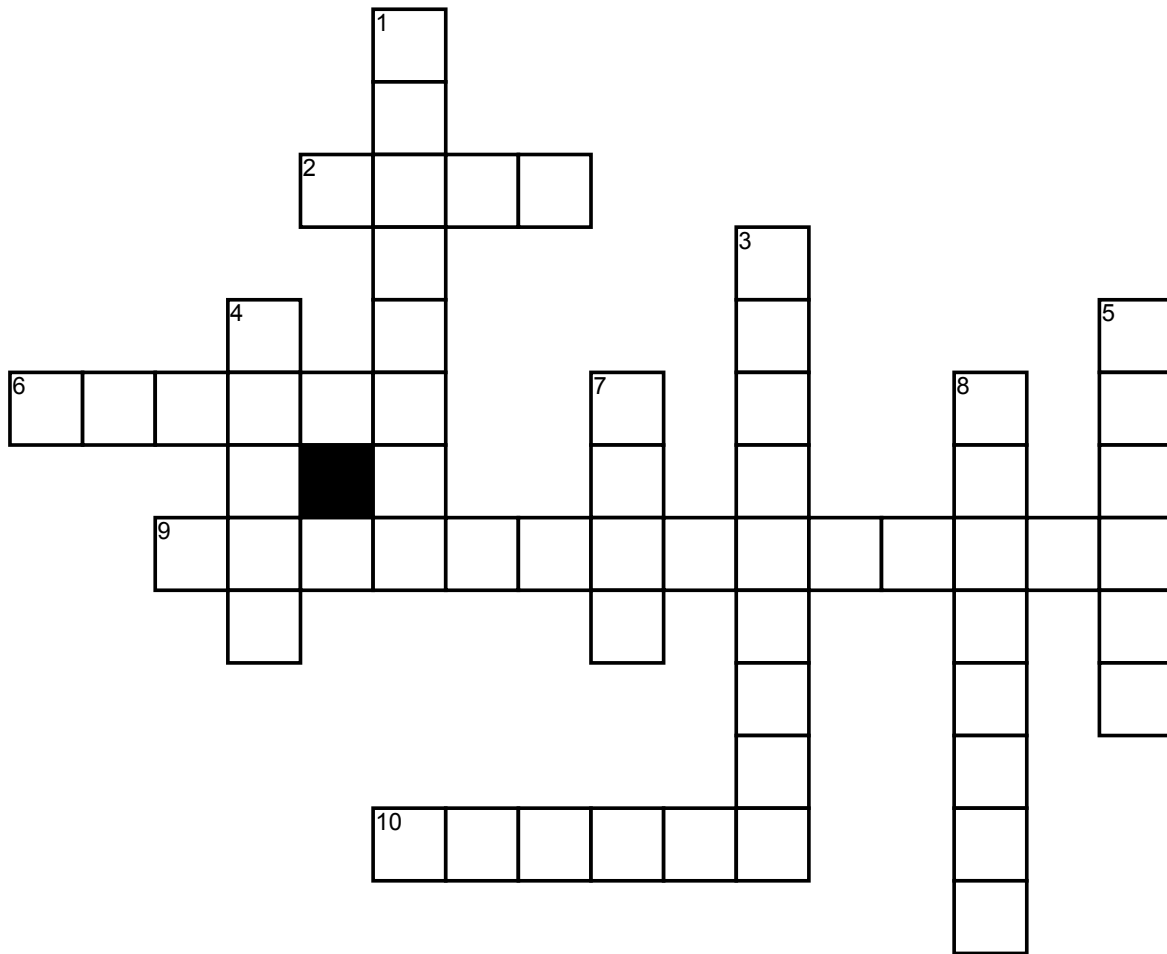


# Unit 3 Arkansas History Crossword
