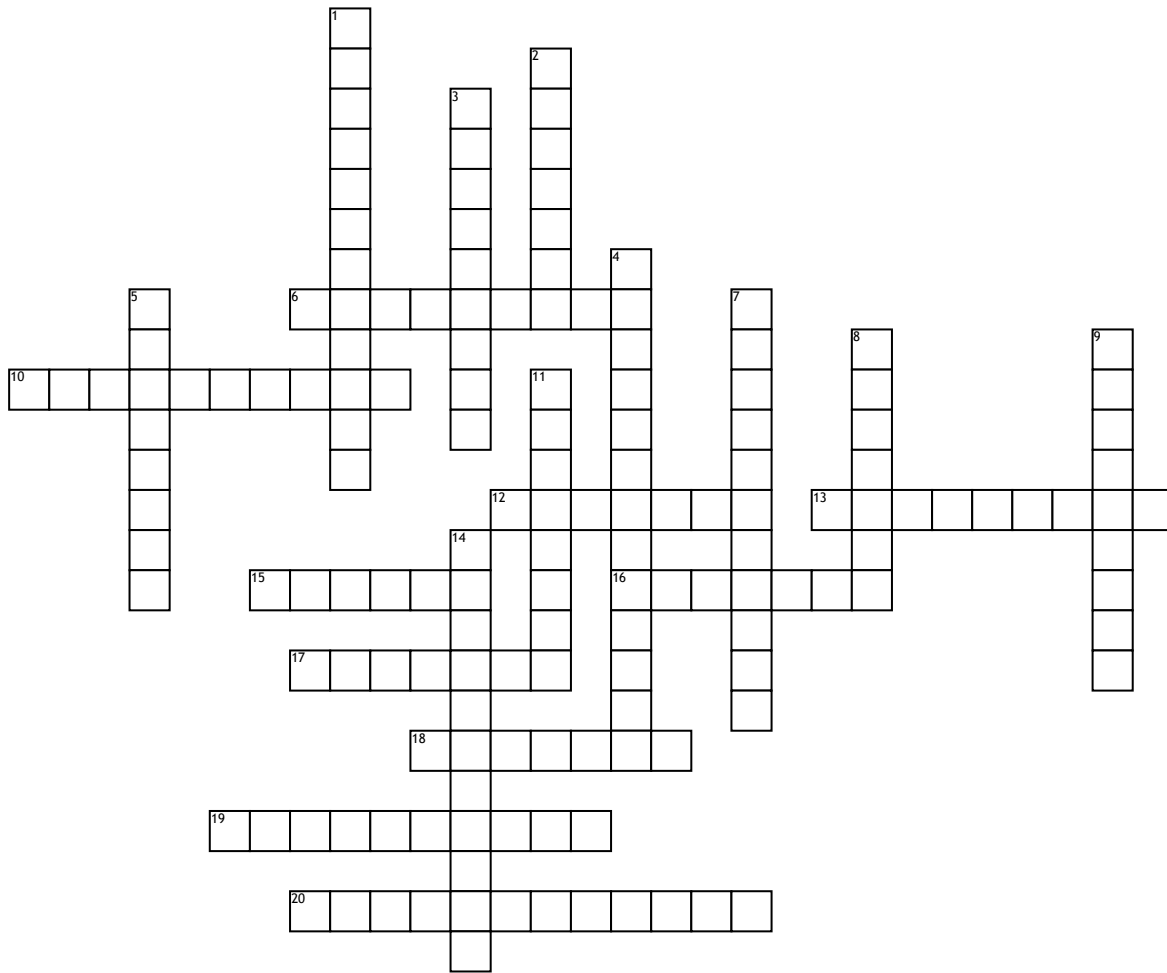


# Unit 3 Vocab Crossword
