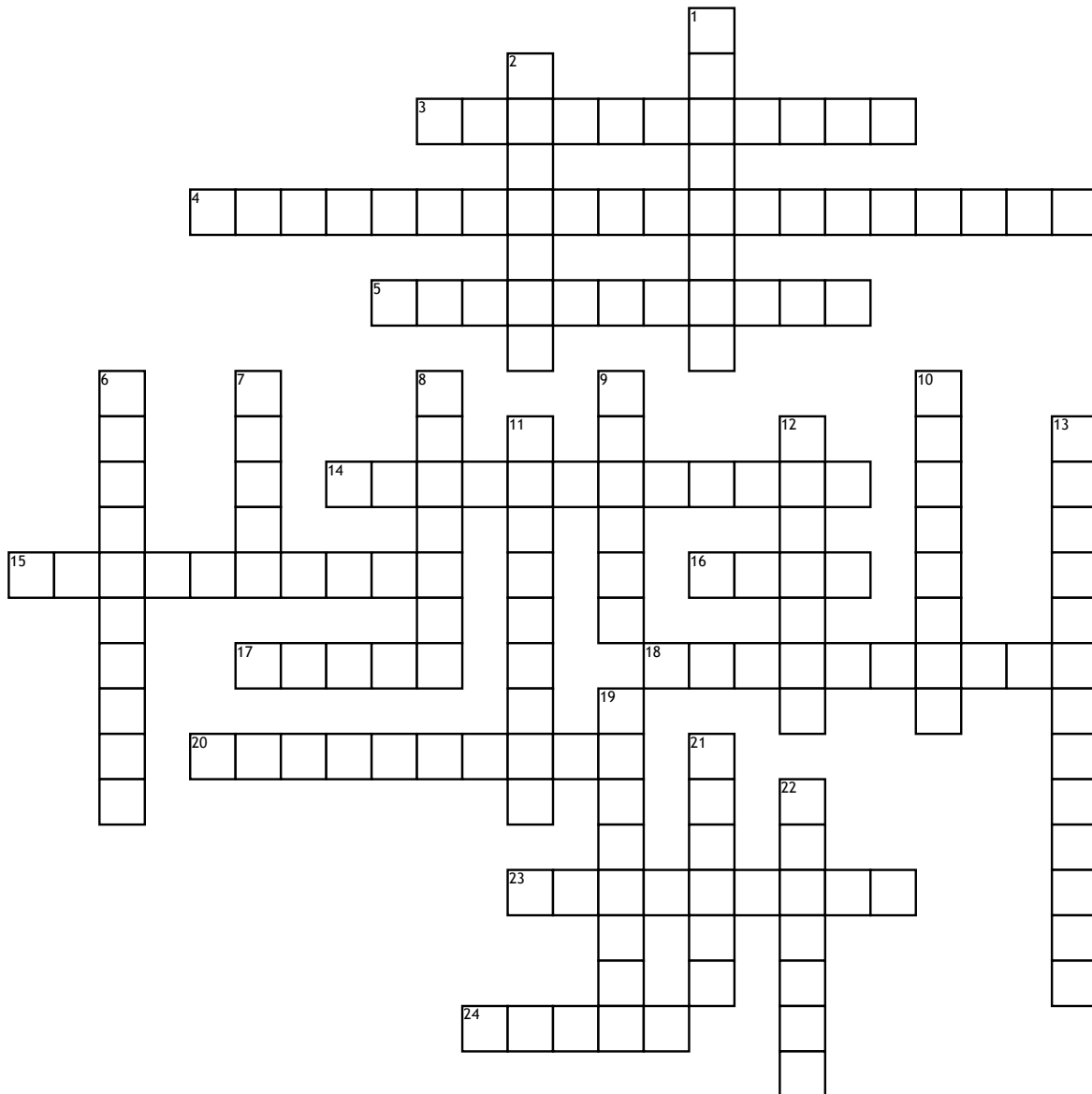


Unit 7 Bones

3. Small bones of the wrist
 4. Bones making up the limbs pelvis and shoulder areas
 5. Portion of the pelvis that extends between the edges of the iliac bones
 14. The site of close approximation of two or more bones
 15. A large process found only on the femur
 16. The prominent expand end of a bone
 17. Cavity in the skull filled with air

18. Portion of the pelvis that extends between the pelvic brim
 20. A rough raised bump usually for muscle attachments
 23. Un-fused area of an infants skull

1. A small rounded process
 2. A projection or raised area
 6. A bump superior today a condyle facet, a flat surface
 7. A furrow or depression
 8. immovable joints of the skull
 9. Groove or elongated depression

10. A small rounded process
 11. A lateral curvature of the spine
 12. A round opening in a bone, usually a passageway for vessels and nerves
 13. The skeleton that forms the central supporting axis of the body
 19. An exaggerated thoracic curvature
 21. A tube-like opening
 22. Rounded knob; usually fits into a fossa in another bone to form a joint
