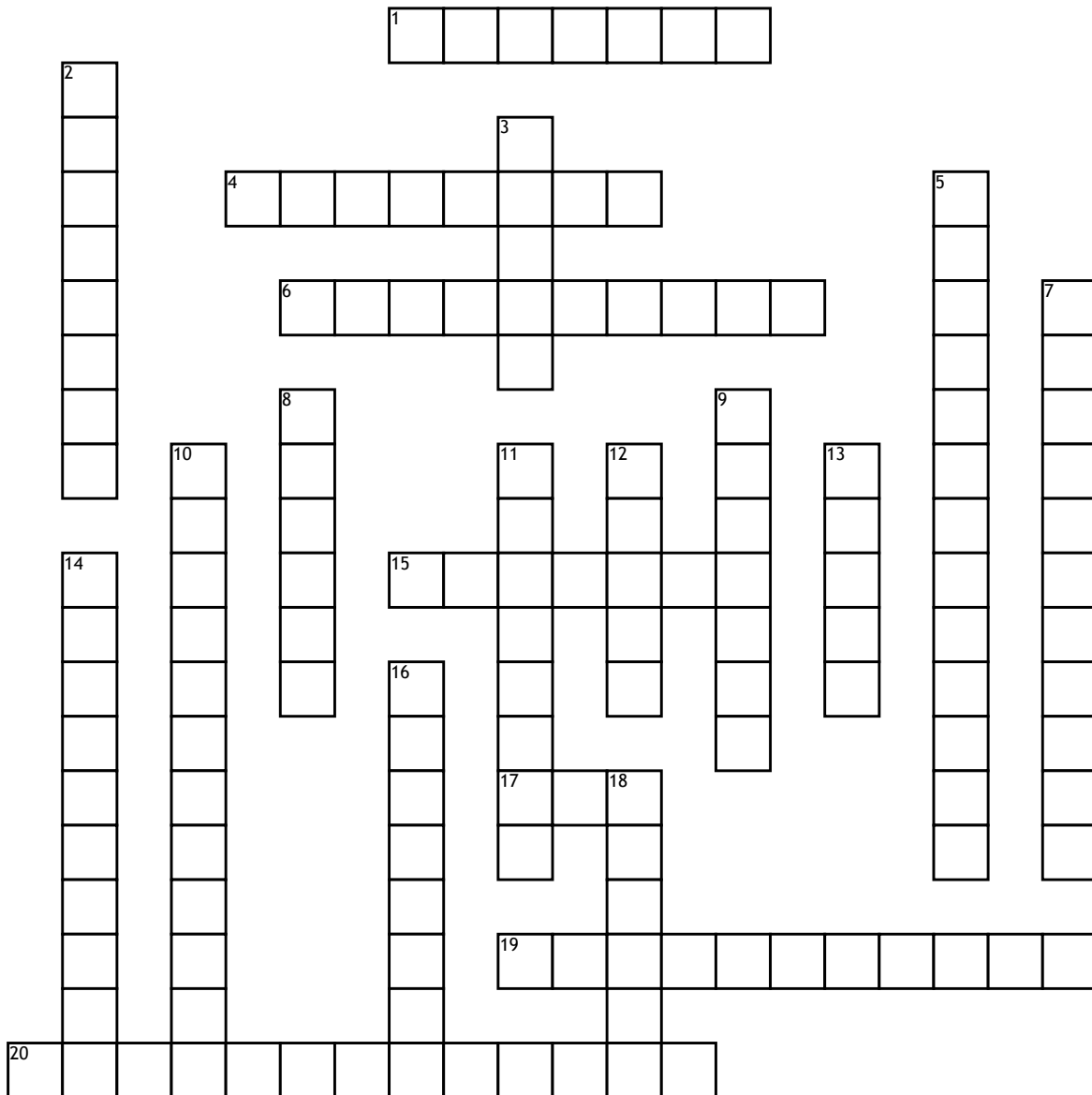


Unit History Crossword
