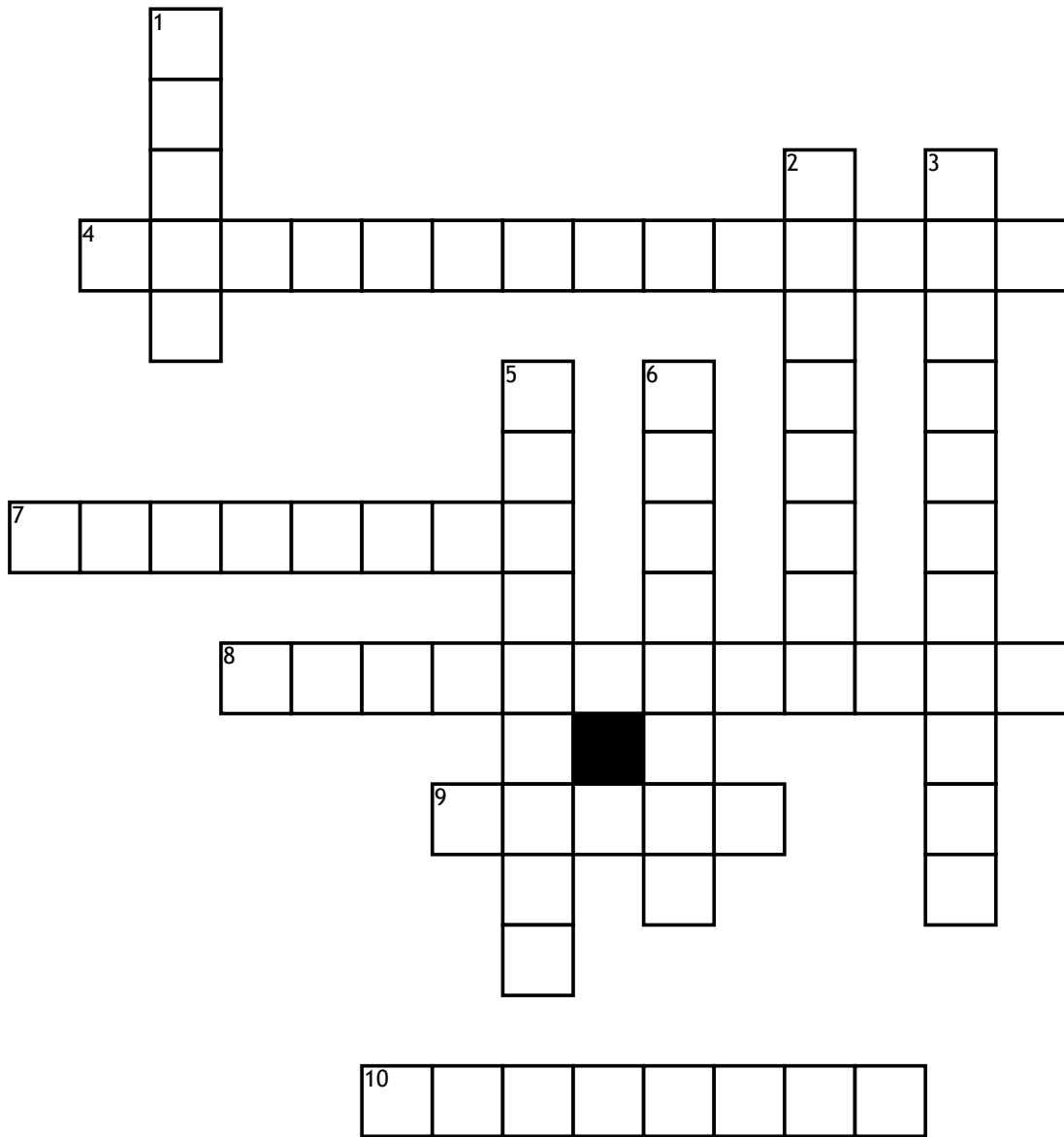


Urinary Medical Terms
