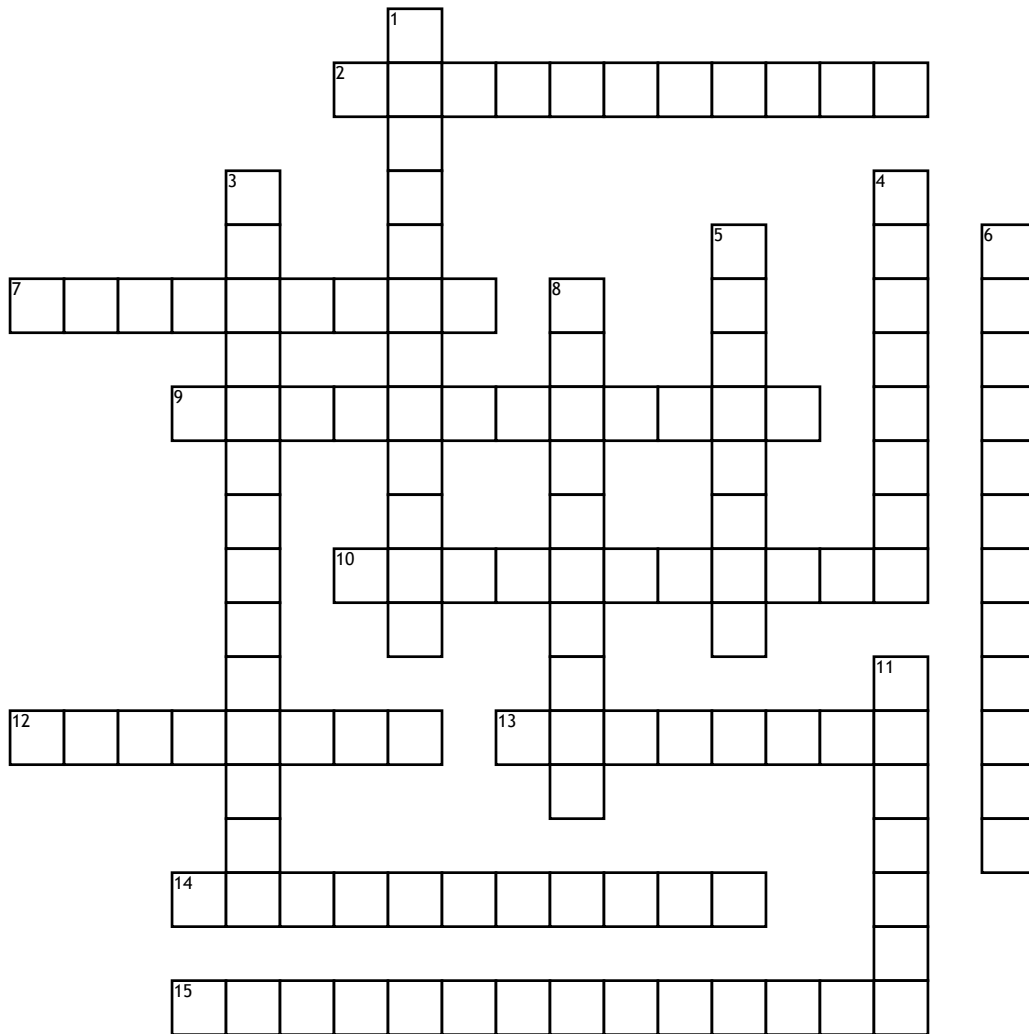


Urinary Terminology

2. the surgical fixation of a floating or mobile kidney (nephroptosis)

7. surgical removal of a calculus (stone) from the bladder, kidney, or urinary tract.

9. the location where the renal pyramids in the medulla empty urine into the minor calyx in the kidney.

10. a treatment, typically using ultrasound shock waves, by which a kidney stone or other calculus is broken into small particles that can be passed out by the body.

12. relating to newborn children (or mammals).

13. the production of abnormally small amounts of urine.

14. having a tendency to mix with, dissolve in, or be wetted by water.

15. inflammation of the substance of the kidney as a result of bacterial infection.

5. the clinical purification of blood by dialysis, as a substitute for the normal function of the kidney.

11. A flower-shaped or funnel-shaped structure; specifically one of the branches or recesses of the pelvis of the kidney into which the orifices of the renal pyramids project.
