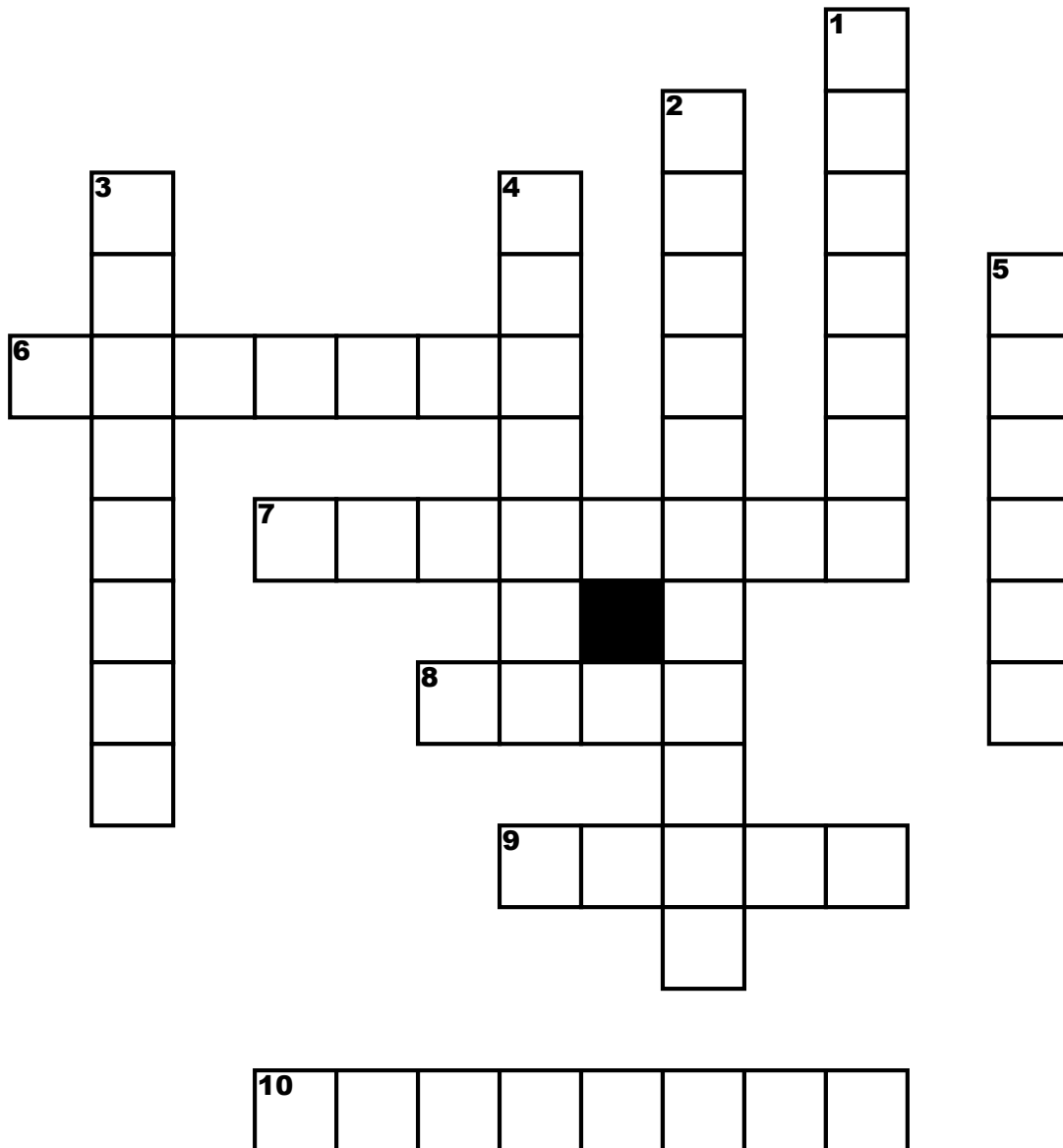

## **Across**

- 6.** tube that extends distally from the urinary bladder
- 7.** excessive acid in the body
- 8.** by product of protein metabolism

## **Down**

- 1.** the duct by which urine passes from the kidney to the bladder or cloaca.

- 3.** a regulatory substance produced in an organism and transported in tissue fluids such as blood to stimulate specific cells into action.
- 4.** pelvic organ for storage of filtrate (urine)
