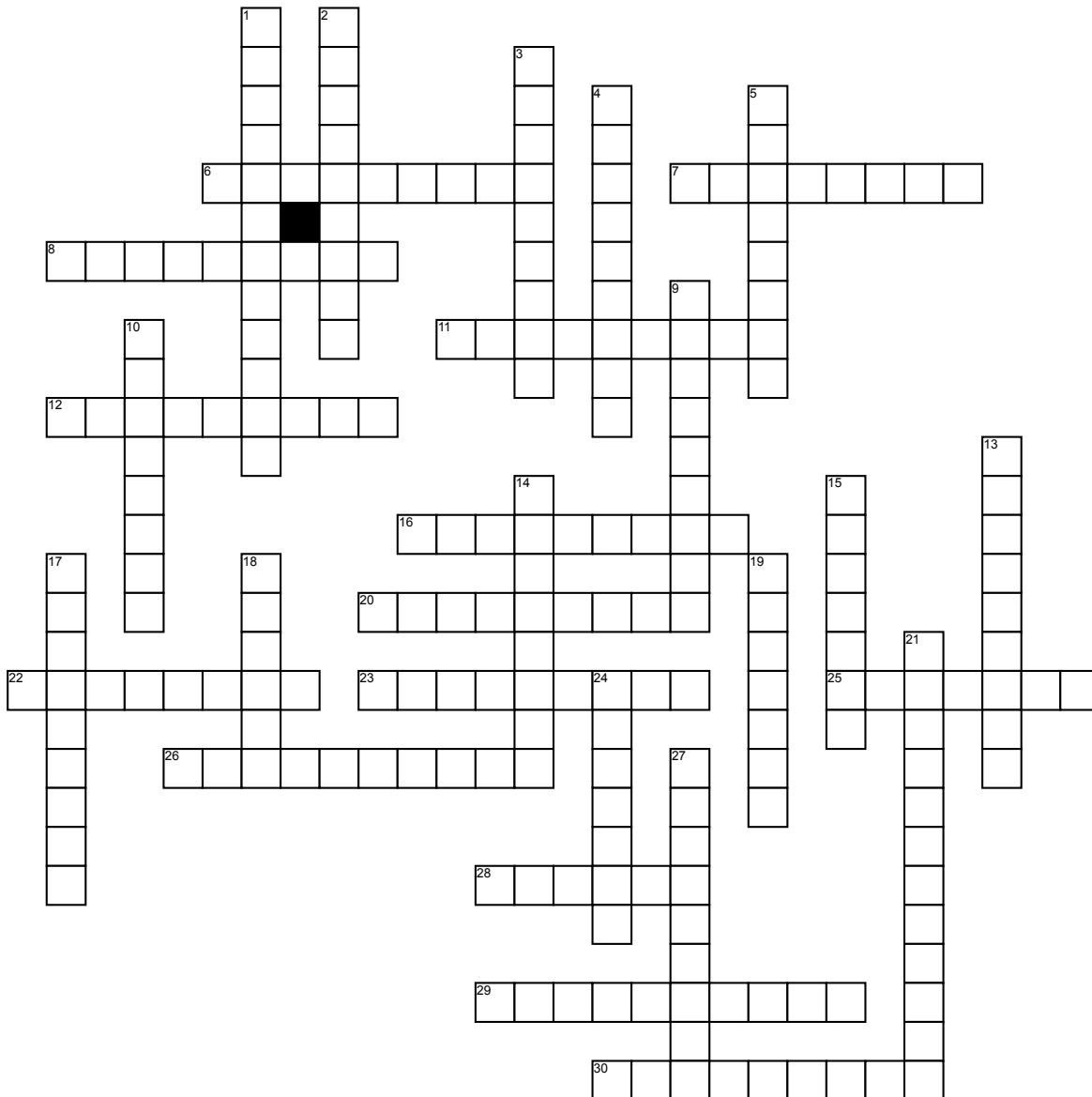


VIC #2 Crossword Puzzle
