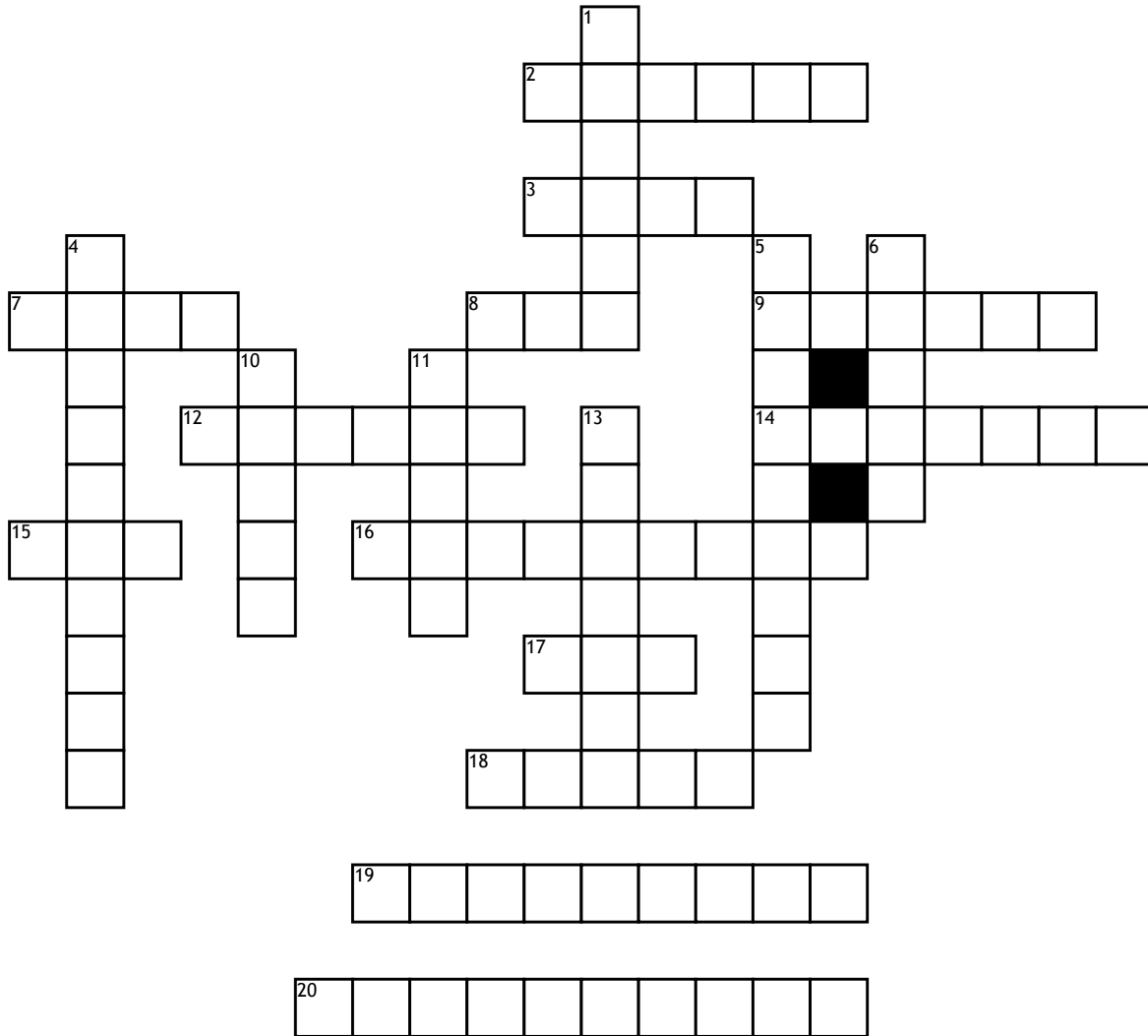


Valentine's Day - February 14
