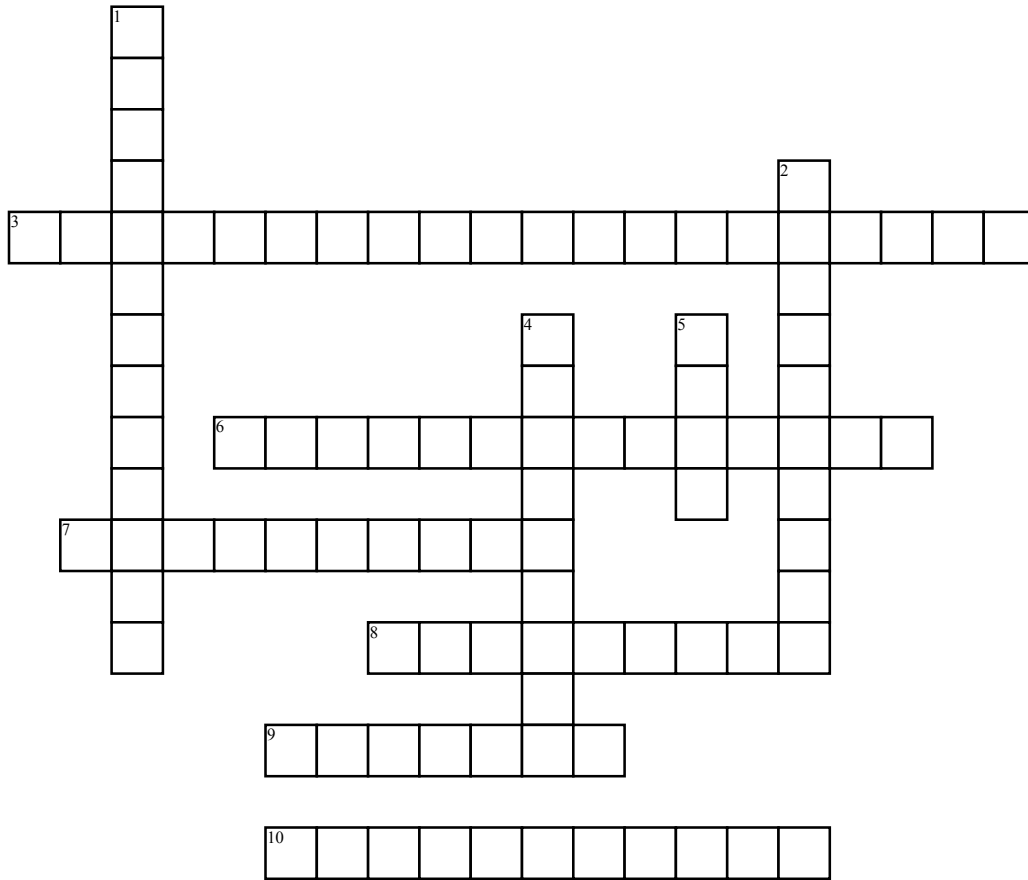


Venezuelan/Afghanistan Conflict

- 1. president from 2013 to present (although disputed by officials). Faced protests and economic crises.
- 2. guerrilla fighters in Islamic countries, especially those who are fighting against non-Muslim forces.
- 4. a country on the northern coast of South America, consisting of a continental landmass and a large number of small islands and islets in the Caribbean Sea.
- 5. The International Security Assistance Force was a NATO-led security mission in Afghanistan, established by the United Nations Security Council in December 2001.
