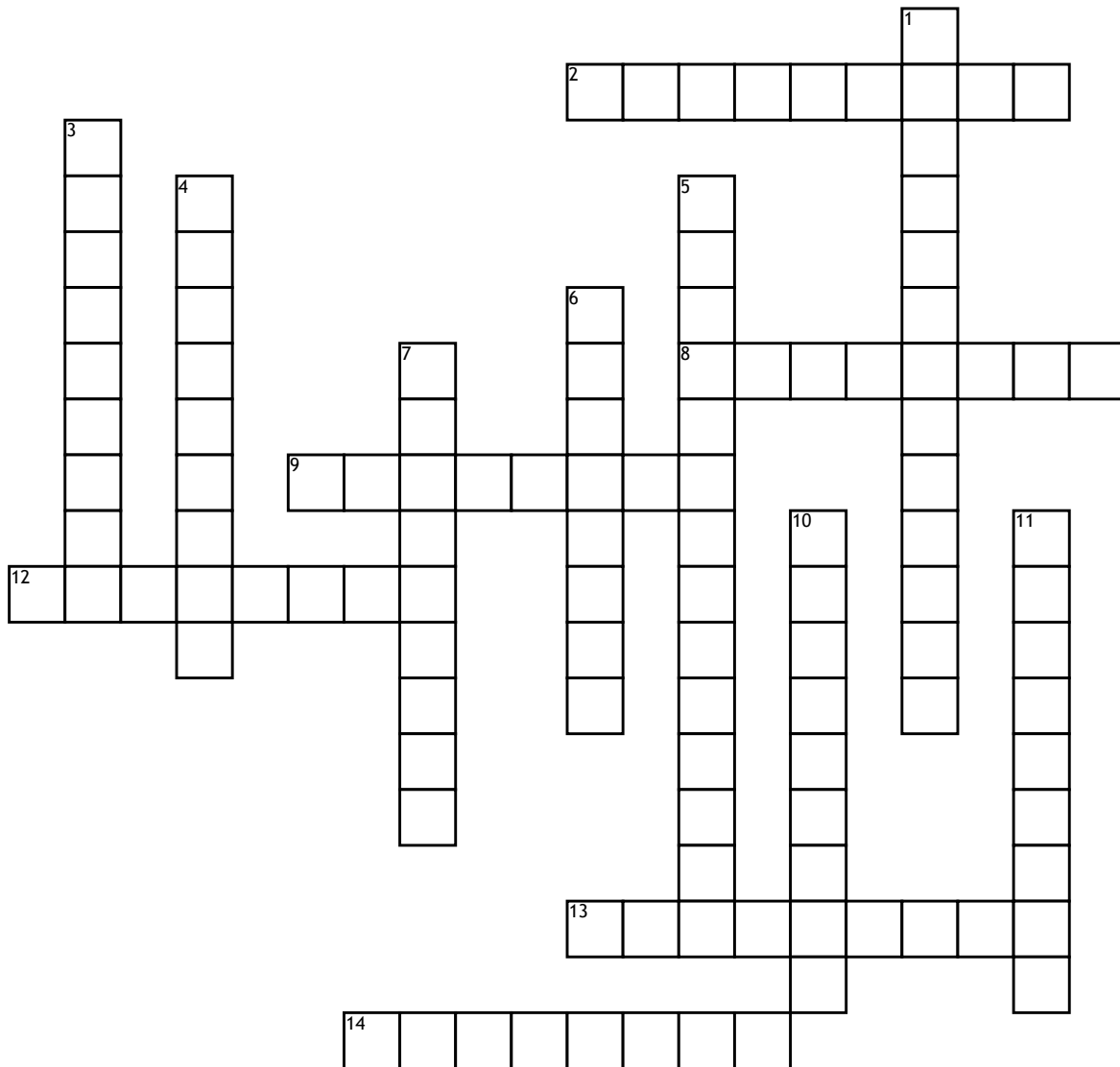


Vertebrate Crossword

- 2. Long, torpedo shaped fish are ambush predators
- 8. Flat shaped and lie on the sea floor waiting for their prey to swim by
- 9. Monotreme
- 12. Reptiles that have skulls with no temporal holes; turtles and tortoises
- 13. Reptiles that had one hole in each temporal region; mammals
- 14. Marsupial

Down

- 1. Fish that are flattened from side to side cannot swim quickly and are very maneuverable. They are usually found on coral reefs, in dense algae beds, or in large schools
- 3. Tiger
- 4. Reflects how a bird flies
- 5. Use camouflage to hide from their predators or prey
- 6. Reptiles that have two holes in each temporal region, one above the other; birds, lizards, and crocodilians
- 7. Reflects what a bird eats
- 10. Varies based on the bird's niche (most birds have four toes)
- 11. Have flattened heads and mouths that point up, which allows them to slurp to invertebrates from the surface while avoiding predators
