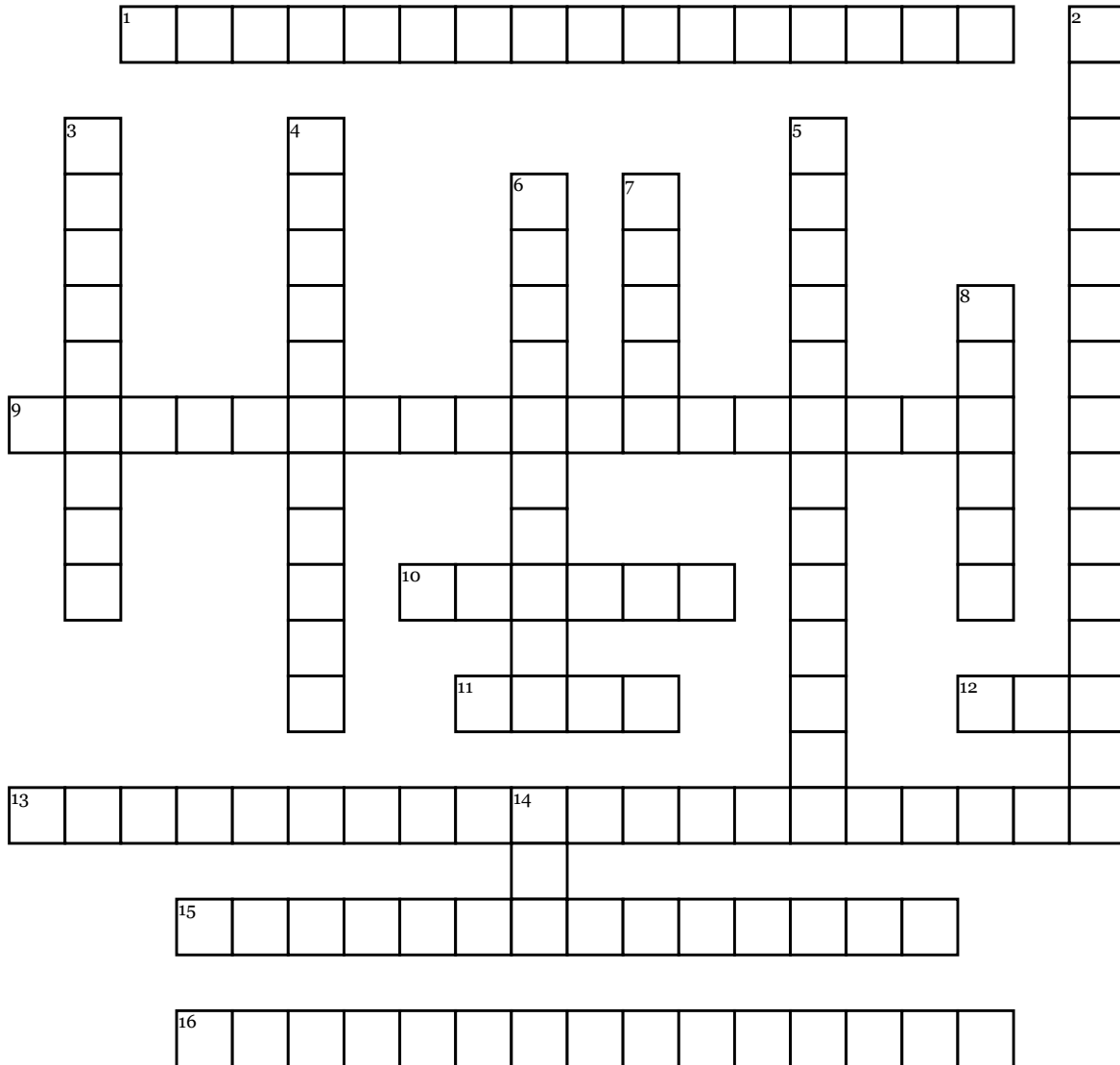


# Vet. Safety

- 7. Causes a disease that is not treatable and must run its course
