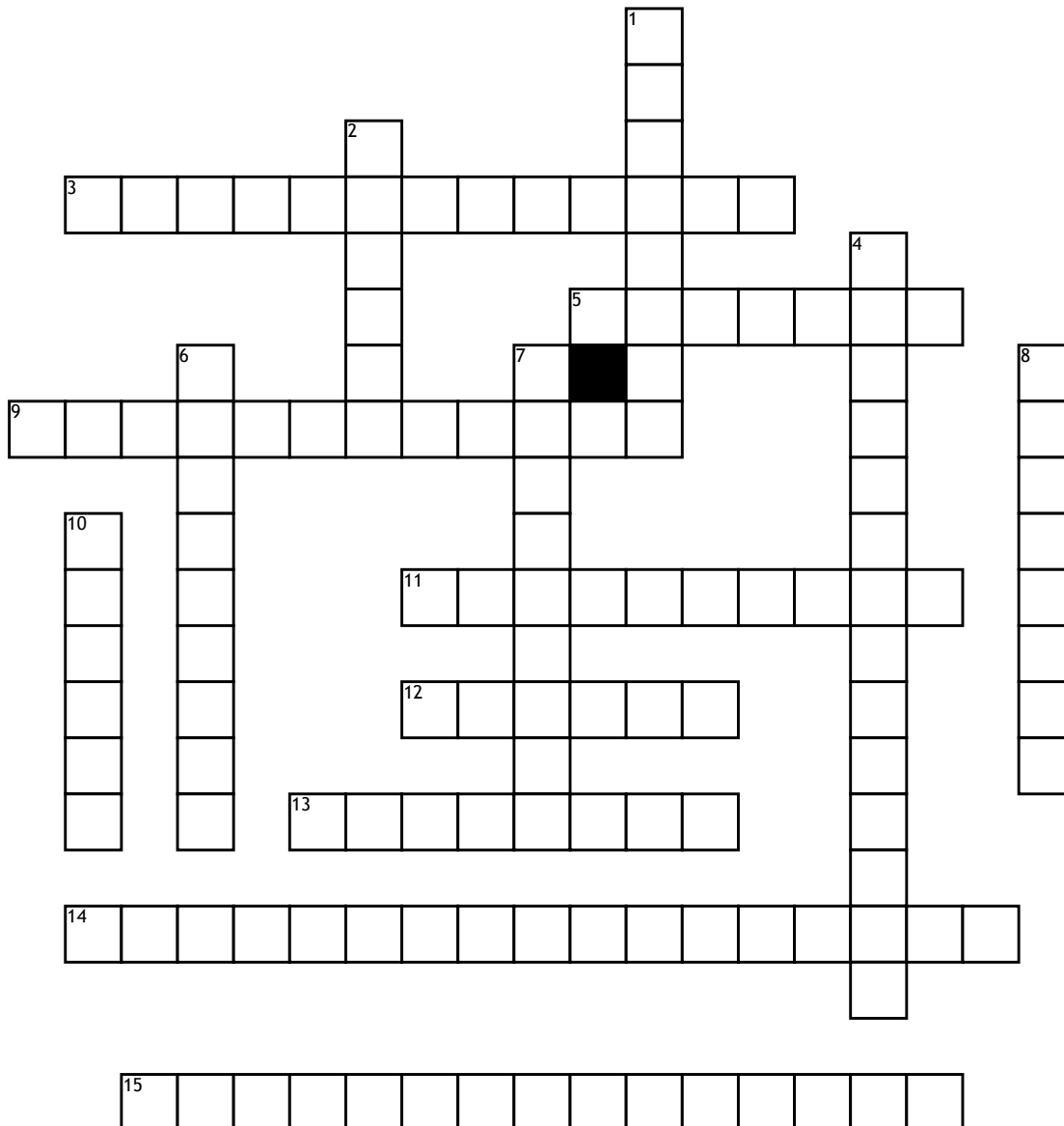

- 1. a disease that results from a decrease in corticosteroid secretion from the adrenal gland
- 2. A lack of muscle coordination, usually causing an abnormal or staggered gait.
- 4. An inflammation of the lining of the eyelids; may cause pain, redness, itching, and a discharge.
- 6. A condition of blood in the urine.

- 7. The narrowing of an organ of passage such as a blood vessel or intestine.
- 8. A hormone that stimulates milk flow in lactating mammals (females nursing their young), and contractions of the muscles of the reproductive tract in many species.
- 10. Digestive enzyme, produced by the pancreas, which breaks down fat.
