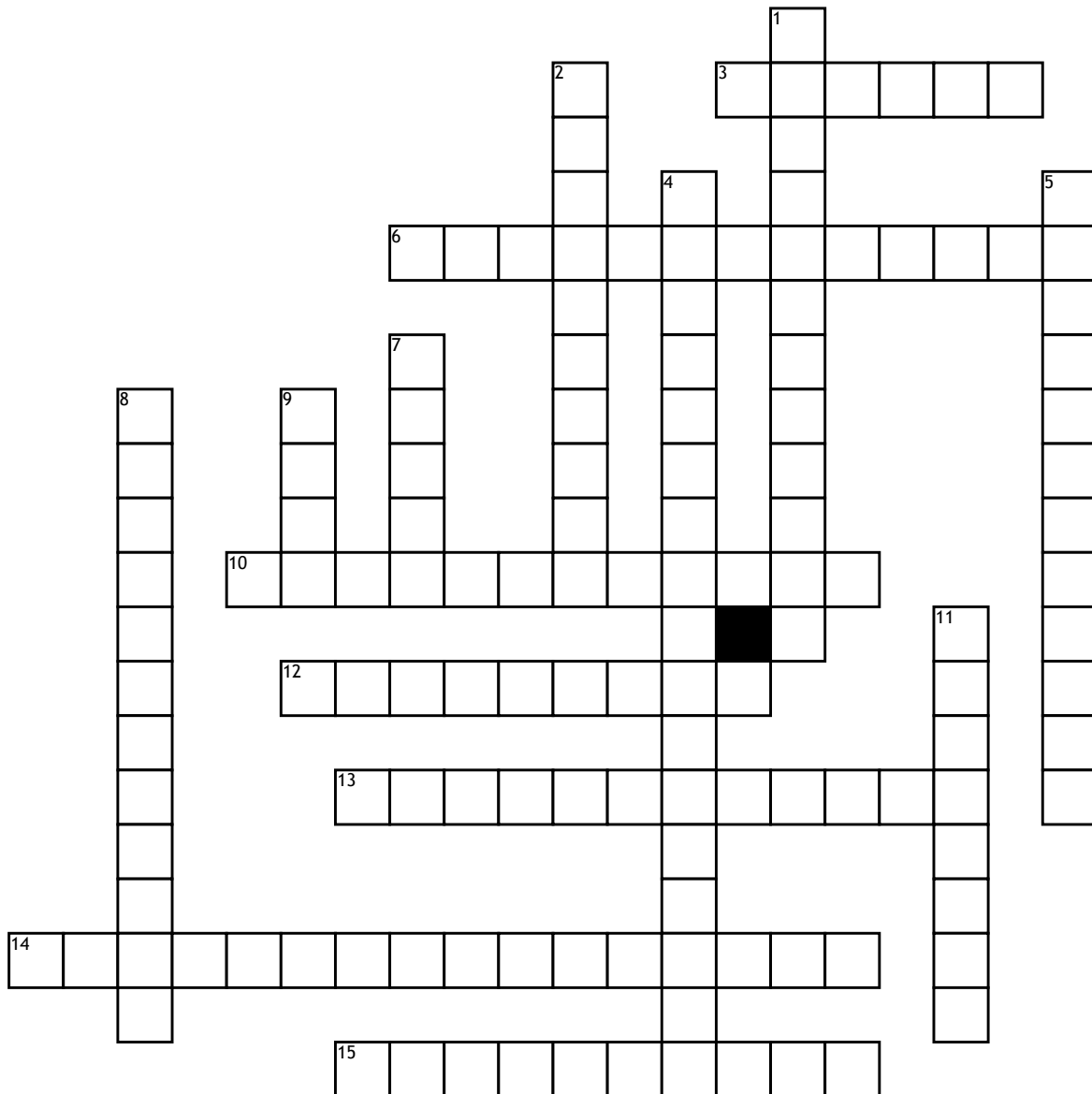


Vietnam and Korean war
