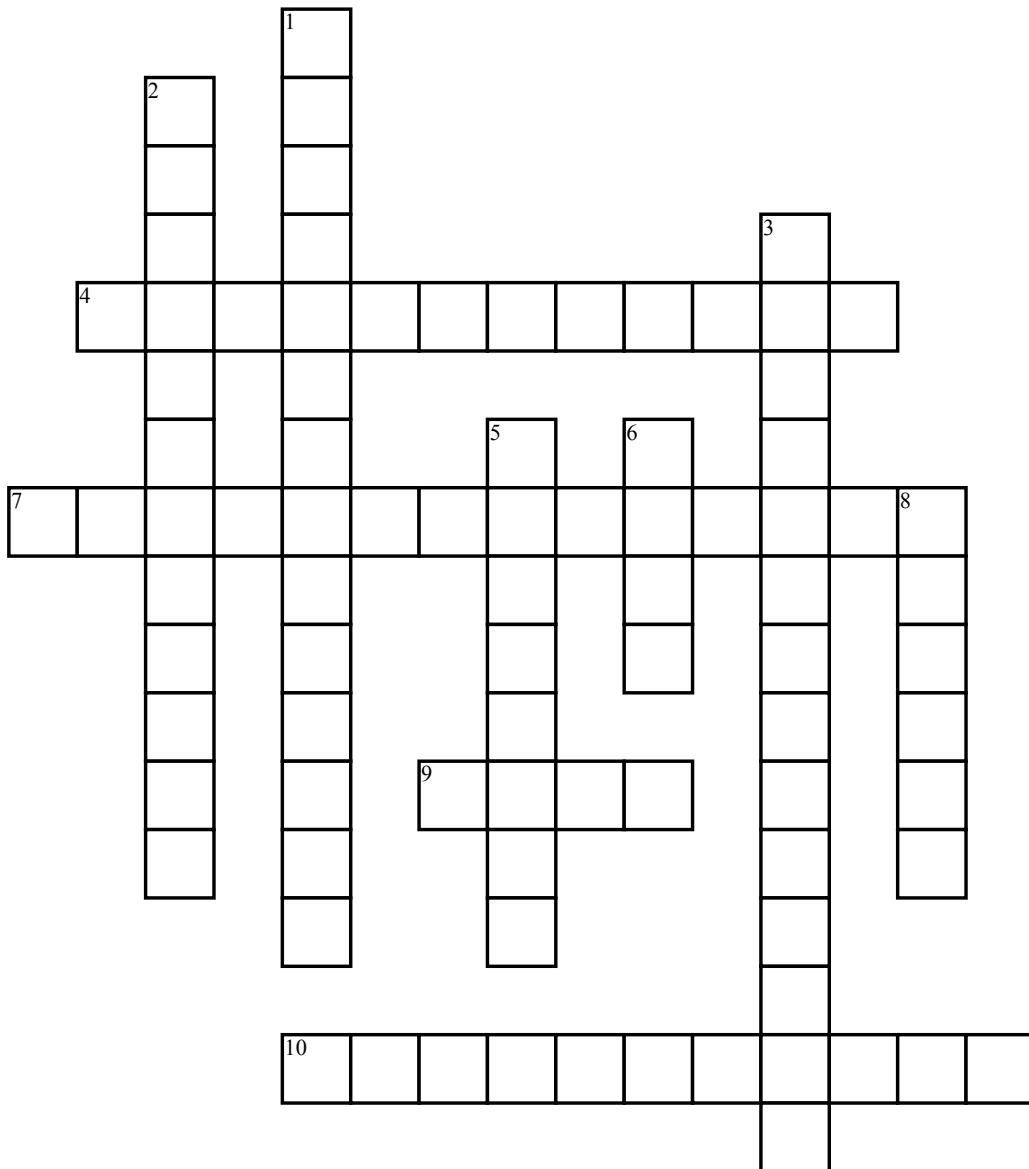

**4.** a theory that if one country is taken over by an expansionist, especially Communist, neighbor, party, or the like, the nearby nations will be taken over one after another.

**7.** a U.S. policy during the Vietnam War of giving the South Vietnamese government responsibility for carrying on the war, so as to allow for the withdrawal of American troops.

**9.** a person who advocates peaceful or conciliatory policies, especially in foreign affairs.

**10.** used by U.S. armed forces during the Vietnam War to defoliate jungles.

**1.** a network of jungle paths winding from North Vietnam through Laos and Cambodia into South Vietnam, used as a military route by North Vietnam to supply the Vietcong during the Vietnam War.

**2.** an offensive by Vietcong and North Vietnamese forces against South Vietnamese and U.S. positions in South Vietnam, beginning on Jan. 31, 1968, the start of Tet.

**3.** a lack of popular confidence in the truth of the claims or public statements made by the federal government, large corporations, politicians

**5.** a Communist-led army and guerrilla force in South Vietnam that fought its government and was supported by North Vietnam.

**6.** a person who advocates an aggressive or warlike policy, especially in foreign affairs.

**8.** a highly flammable sticky jelly used in incendiary bombs and flamethrowers, consisting of gasoline thickened with special soaps.
