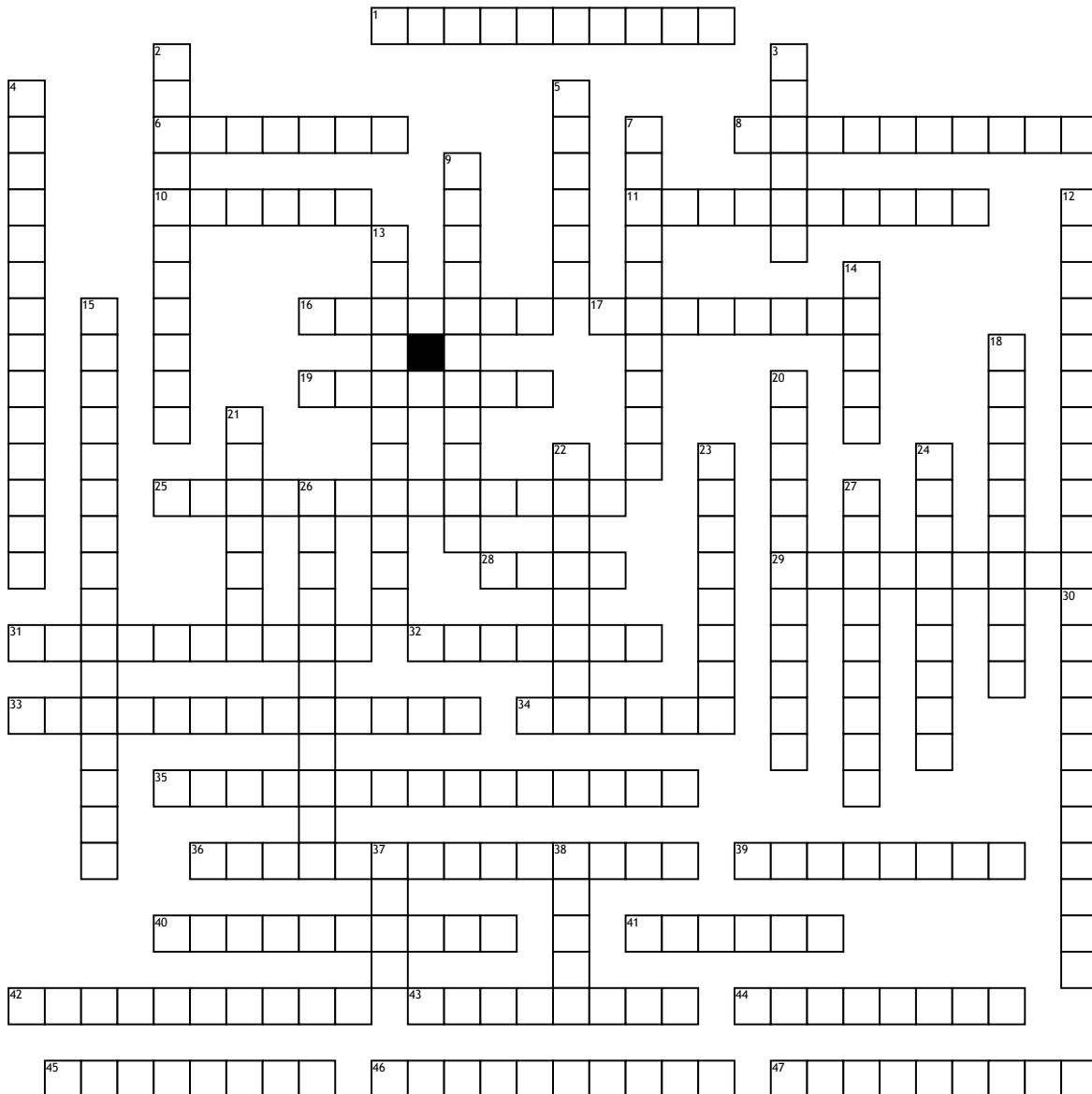


# Vocab. Crossword Puzzle
