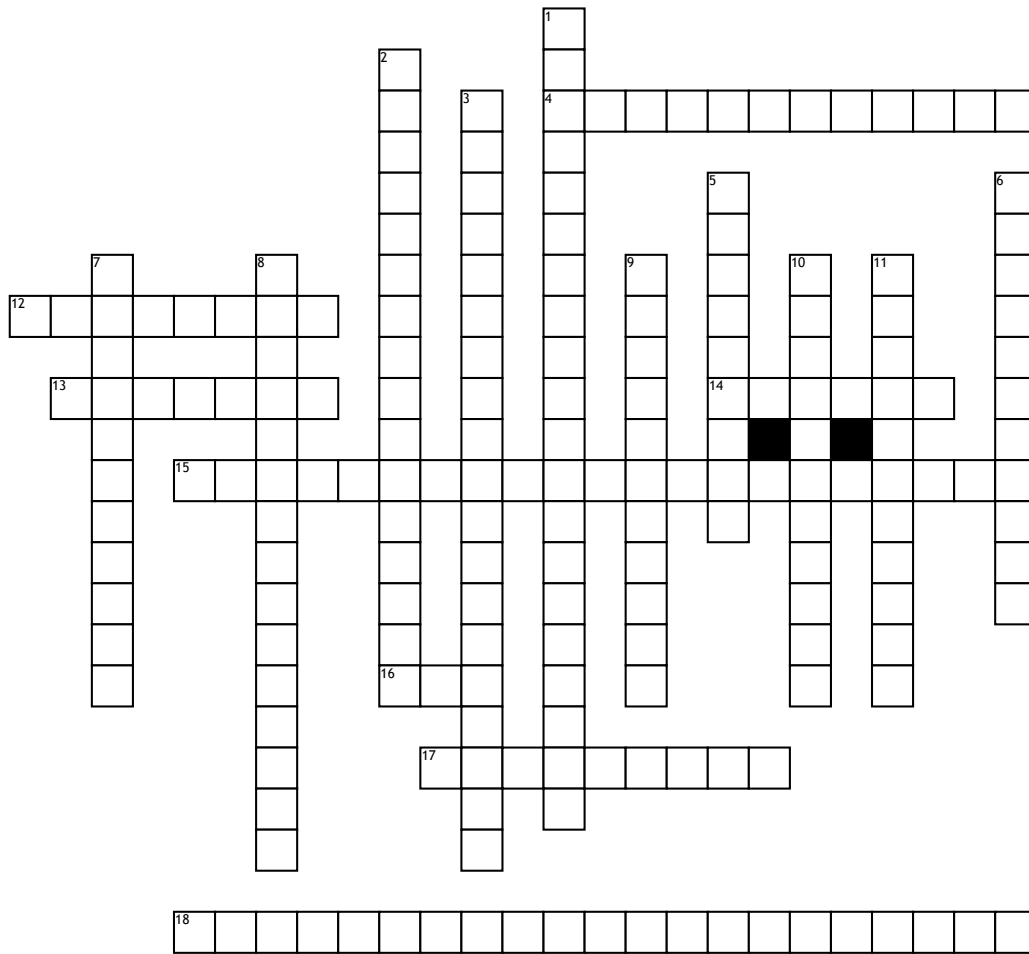


Vocab Crossword Puzzle
