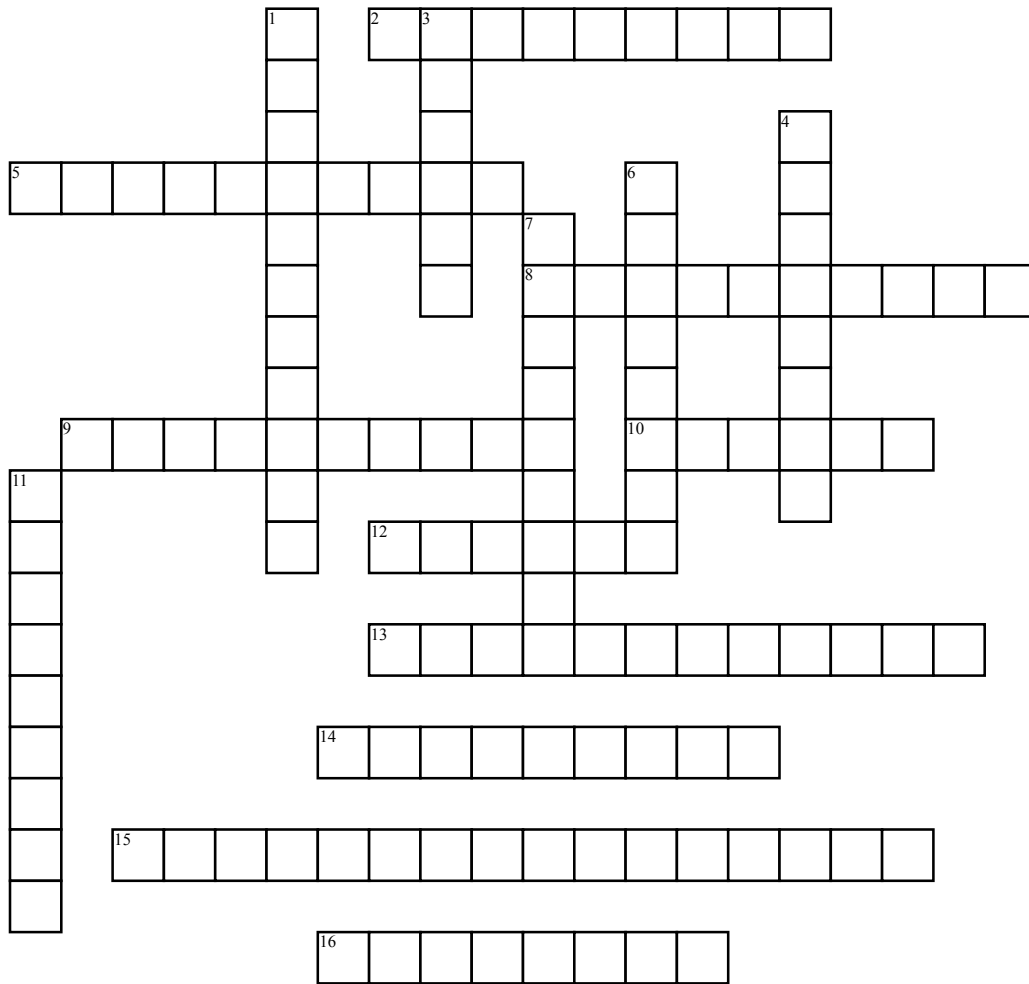


Vocab Menu Crossword
