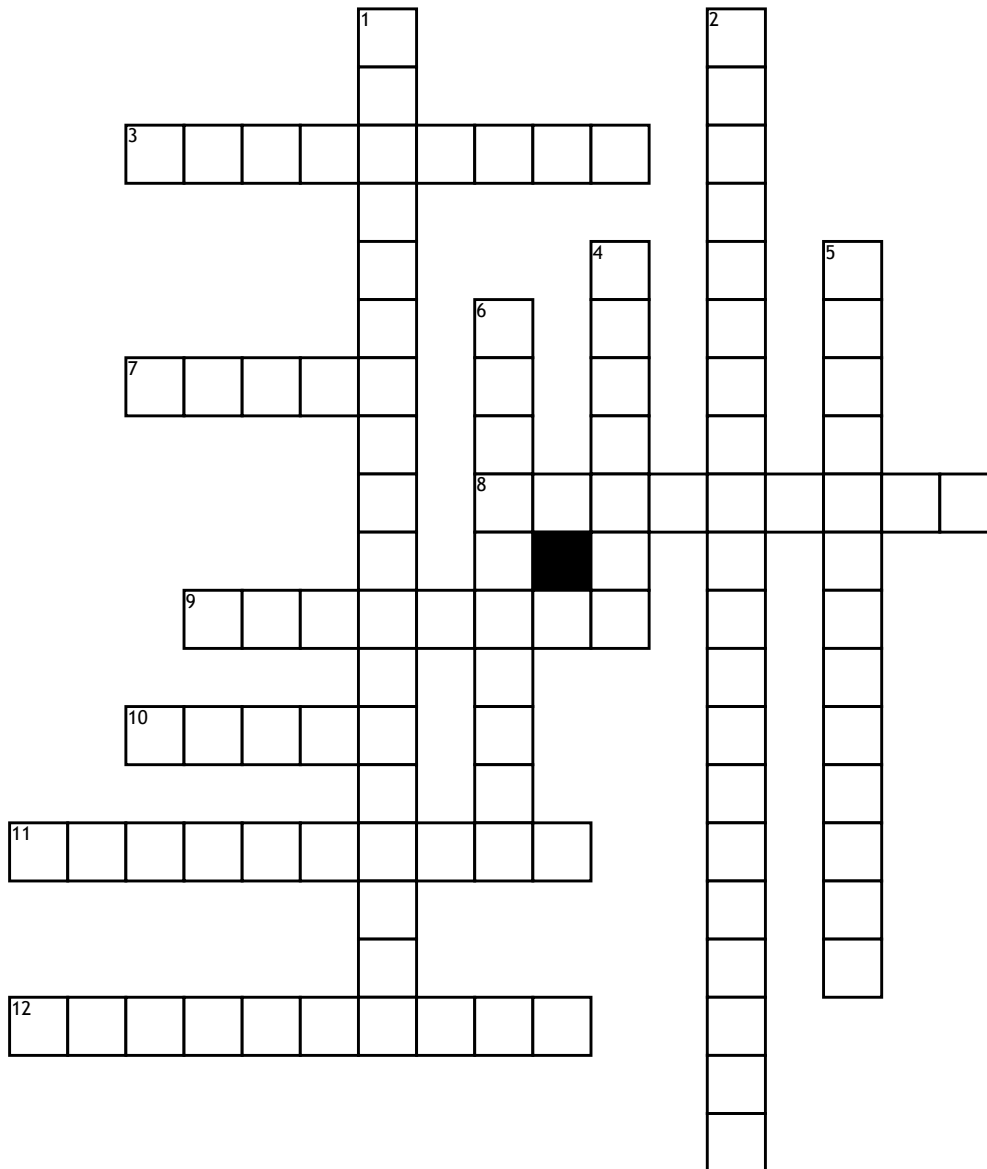


Vocab Preview Crossword Puzzle
