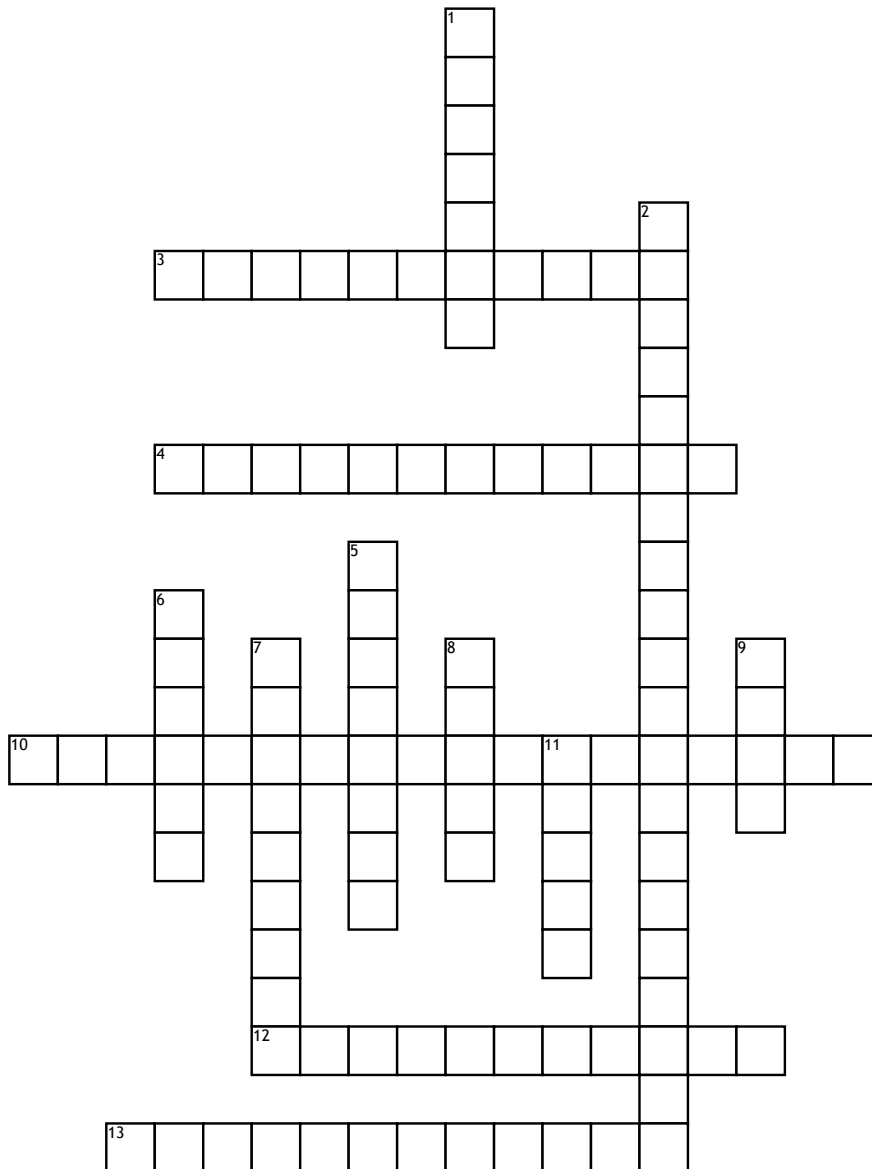

13. Break up of a rock because of freezing water that tries to expand within cracks.

1. Soil and rocks fragments mixed with water that falls quickly down hill.

2. Smaller fragments originated from a physical disintegration of a rock.

5. Layer that nearly covers Earth made out of mineral or rock fragments.

6. Mass of rocks or unconsolidated material that slips downwards and moves as a whole.

7. Multiple rocks that slide downward very fast.

8. Slow movement of soil and regolith that goes downhill.

9. A mixture of organic and mineral matter, air and water. It supports plant growth.
